Application for Citizens' Oversight Committee Membership

The Board of Trustees of the Southern Kern Unified School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the Citizens' Oversight Committee. This committee will provide oversight and accountability to ensure that Measure H (2024 Bond Measure) funds are used as they were intended.

Duties of the Committee Members include:

- Ensure Bond funds are spent only on projects listed in the Bond Project Lists and that no funds are used for salaries or general operating expenses.
- Monitor progress of Bond projects.
- Receive and review copies of the annual performance and financial audits of Bond projects as required by California State law.
- Provide information to the public on the progress of Bond projects and expenditures of Bond funds.
- Present to the Board in public session, annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of bond process of the measures.

Appointment of Committee Members

All appointments will be made by the Board from applications submitted to the District. The Committee shall consist of at least seven members appointed by the Board. State Law also sets forth the types of community members we need on the Oversight Committee. Specifically, we are required to have:

- One active member of a business organization representing the business community located in the district.
- One member is active in a senior citizens' organization.
- One member is active in a taxpayer's association.
- One member shall be a parent or guardian of a pupil currently enrolled in the district.
- One member shall be both a parent or guardian of a pupil currently enrolled in the district and active in a parent-teacher association/club or school site council.
- Two members of the community at-large.

Additional members may represent any of these groups.

Time Commitment and Term

Members shall serve up to three (3) terms of two (2) years each. The committee meets quarterly at various locations.
