Learning Goals

Letters/Letter Sounds to Practice: This week we will learn the letters Zz, Kk and the short sound for Ee.

High Frequency Words to Practice: This week we are learning the words **that, this, there, jump, was**

Phonics: This week we will blend (put together) and segment (take apart) words, and we will change word parts to make new words.

Reading: This week we will learn how to retell a story in our own words by talking about the major events that took place in the book.

Writing: This week we will use a combination of writing and drawing to write our opinion about a book we have read.

Grammar: This week we will learn all about singular and plural nouns.

Science: This week we will learn how to describe time patterns by describing day and night and discussing what we can see in the daytime sky and in the nighttime sky and what activities are most appropriate to do during the day and during the night (example: When do we eat breakfast? When do we sleep?)

Math: This week we will learn how solve real world problems by using addition and subtraction strategies.
