Mrs. Ferris has been traveling to classrooms to introduce our new school culture and climate theme:

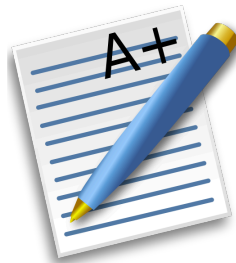

Nurses Corner



Winter lice screenings have begun! Per district policy 8454 Management of Pediculosis each student at CEL will be screened for lice prior to the end of January.

Students who are not feeling well should not attend school. Students can not return to school until they are free of fever, vomiting, or diarrhea for 24 hours without medication. Cough drops should be brought from home and must be kept in the health office. Students may not have cough drops in their classrooms.

If your student is going to be absent for any reason be sure to call the absentee line at 973-875-8820. As always, if any health concerns develop or you have any questions/concerns over the school year please feel free to contact me via email or phone.

Here at CEL we make every effort for the students to get outdoors. Students need to be wearing coats, hats and gloves everyday to school (be sure to label with their names). All students should be dressed in layers! It is recommended that each student at CEL brings an extra pair of clothing, including socks and underwear with them to school. If your child is sent home in a new pair of clothing provided from the school, please wash and return the clothing. **Gently worn size 7T and up sweatpants, leggings, long sleeves donations are being accepted along with any size unopened underwear/socks.**

DENTAL VAN



A wonderful opportunity is knocking at the Sussex-Wantage School District's door! A Mobile Dental Clinic, Zufall Health Center, which provides dental services, will be coming to our school district on February 11, 2025.

This is an opportunity which is available to ALL of our students.

We realize that some of our students may not have dental insurance, and those who have NJ Family Care and Medicaid have limited options because only a few local dentists accept this type of insurance. Here is an opportunity to get the dental care your student needs.

In order for your child to be seen, their last dental visit has to have been more than six months ago!

If you have private insurance, and would like your child seen, please call the Zufall Center for more information regarding that at 973-862-6650. If your child has no dental insurance the first visit is free. Students who have Medicaid will be fully covered. Zufall will be providing dental exams/screenings, cleanings and x-rays. Your child will receive dental health education and a free toothbrush!

Please consider taking advantage of this wonderful opportunity knocking at our door. Sign your child up today! The deadline to register is Tuesday, January 28, 2025. Please contact your school nurse for permission and registration forms.
