A family may apply if it includes a pregnant woman or a child ages birth through three years old. The Head Start/Early Head Start programs are funded through the United States Department of Health and Human Services. Each enrolled child attends at no cost and receives center-based or home-based services, which include:

- A full day program focusing on literacy using a research-based curriculum
- Ongoing assessments to monitor the child's progress
- Services that include dental, health, vision, hearing, nutrition, mental health, disability and family support

Although most Head Start /Early Head Start families must meet income eligibility guidelines, we are allowed to take a certain percentage of families whose incomes exceed the federal income poverty levels.

The recruitment process for these programs is ongoing. However, please note that space is limited. January is recruitment campaign month; we hope to help many of our families through the process in the next few weeks.
