Levies are for Learning

This EP&O Levy is **not a new tax.** It replaces the 2021 voterapproved levy, which expires in
2025. Levy dollars fund things
that the state does not and bridge
the gap between what the state
pays for and what it *actually* costs
to run a school district.







This Education Programs & Operations (EP & O) Levy is to collect \$11,521,730 in 2026-2029 which allows us to access Local Effort Assistance (LEA) of over **\$13,000,000** over those 4 years.

The projected rate, assuming a district assessed valuation increase of 2% next year and 4% each of the following years, is \$1.85 per \$1,000 of assessed property value each year.

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
Monthly Cost - Estimated conthly cost for a \$375K home assuming an assessed value of increase of 4% in 2026-2029






Approved past and projected future levy rates* per \$1,000 of assessed property value... *Future levy rates are estimates

For a district to be able to fully access LEA, the actual levy rate must be between \$1.50 and \$2.50 per \$1,000.


Percentage of total revenue that is generated by local property taxes in Ephrata, in Grant County and statewide...

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






Rationale for this EP & O Levy, including the approx. \$500,000 increase in levy collection from 2025 to 2026...







UNFUNDED MATERIALS, SUPPLIES & OPERATING COSTS








