ELIGIBILITY

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Have a weighted and unweighted cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better (on a 4.0 scale)
- Have been accepted for admission or currently attending SC State University
- Demonstrated leadership and community service
- Submitted FAFSA to SC State University; Use code 003346
- Submit an official transcript
- Submit test scores of a minimum of 21 ACT and/or 1080 SAT

- Bachelor of Science in Family and Consumer Sciences Child Development
