



COMMUNITY USE POLICY

Outline Statement

The facilities at Dulwich College are used by Dulwich College Enterprises Limited (“DCE”) at times when they are not required for educational purposes. DCE is a wholly owned subsidiary of the College. Its net profits are covenanted to the College and help the College achieve its charitable objectives (e.g. by offering financial assistance with school fees to those in need).

As an active member of the local community, the College at times permits the use of its facilities by charitable, local or community-based organisations at reduced rates. These events are organised and booked for the College by DCE.

Does Your Organisation Qualify?

To qualify, your organisation must be one or more of the following:

- A registered local charity
- A local body involved in fundraising work that benefits the local community
- A group that provides a service that benefits the local community
- A local school or organisation with educational aims
- A fundraising body with close links to Dulwich College

Please note:

- Only one community event per organisation, per annum will usually be considered by the College.
- All bookings made with DCE are subject to its standard Terms & Conditions.
- The rates charged are determined by DCE but must at least cover in full the real costs of the event to DCE and the College.
- In the case of charity fundraising events which are being organised jointly with the College please contact the Chief Operating Officer before submitting your application.
