

Celebrating a New Building A 2017 Bond Project

Building

The campus redesign was a collaboration among Spring Branch ISD, Stantec and the Project Advisory Team, composed of staff, parents and community members. Brookstone Construction served as the construction manager at risk for the project. The building features flexible furniture and modern technology to enhance classroom experiences and support collaboration. The building also includes a dining commons space located near the gym for large-scale events.



Community and Nature

The design incorporates views of the surrounding landscape through the use of flex spaces and a central, outdoor-learning courtyard. The courtyard includes access to art & science classrooms, an outdoor classroom with a covered pavilion and direct connections to the Media Center and dining areas. The playground and playfield provide a secure, outdoor environment with a backyard-like setting and preserved mature trees.

The new 104,094-square-foot Woodview Elementary provides an enhanced learning environment with innovative instructional and collaborative spaces. It replaces the previous campus of separate buildings and includes a connected community space under one roof. The new school provides a significant upgrade from the original facility constructed in 1958 and accommodates 700 students.

Collaboration

The Media Center is the heart of the campus, adjacent to grade-level learning areas with direct access to collaborative flex spaces. These spaces feature secure connections to the outdoor learning courtyard, offering unique learning opportunities and exterior views. Shared spaces include art, music, science, gym and covered play areas and a dining area. Instructional support rooms include resource, planning and intervention.



Site Plan

The site includes outdoor features such as a covered play area and playgrounds for various age groups and fences for enhanced security. In addition, the new site layout ensures separate traffic flows for parents, buses and visitors, relieving congestion on Bunker Hill Rd. Woodview offers 35 instructional spaces, including 32 grade-level classrooms and three special education classrooms.



Spring Branch ISD is honored to celebrate the grand opening of the newly constructed Woodview Elementary. Approved by 80 percent of the vote in November 2017, the newly constructed building is part of the 2017 Bond Program. The transformation of district facilities began with the 2007 Bond Program.
