


SCHOOL PROFILE

GRADE LEVEL TEAM STRUCTURE

Brownsburg High School (BHS) is led by a Principal with support from an Associate Principal, four Grade Level Teams and six Secondary Department Heads. The grade level team Assistant Principals matriculate with their cohort students along with an Administrative Assistant, two Academic Coaches, and two Counselors to create a community within each grade level. The six Secondary Department Heads (math, English, science, social studies, world languages & English language learners, and special education) support students and teachers through their instructional leadership.

ADDRESSING COMMUNITY GROWTH

Brownsburg Community School Corporation (BCSC) continues to be one of the fastest growing school corporations in Indiana. To address that growth, a new elementary school opened for the 2023-2024 school year and significant renovations and expansions have recently been completed at the middle school level. In addition, a series of renovation and expansion projects at BHS are nearing completion.



DIVERSE STUDENT BODY

BCSC students are 58% White, 22% Black, 9% Hispanic, 5% Mixed Race, 4% Asian, <1% American Indian, Alaskan Native, Pacific Islander. The number of students who qualify for free or reduced meals at BCSC has steadily increased to 36% in 2024-2025. There are 87 different languages spoken in the homes of our students. Seven percent of BCSC students receive language support. In addition, 15.45% of students PK-13 receive special education services.

STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT #1

Student academic achievement in Indiana is measured by the annual ILEARN test that all 3rd-8th grade students take in the spring. Brownsburg student performance ranked 5th in the state eleven years ago and moved into the top spot in 2016. BCSC has been #1 in the state for the last eight years on the state's standardized assessment.
