Dear Troy Families,

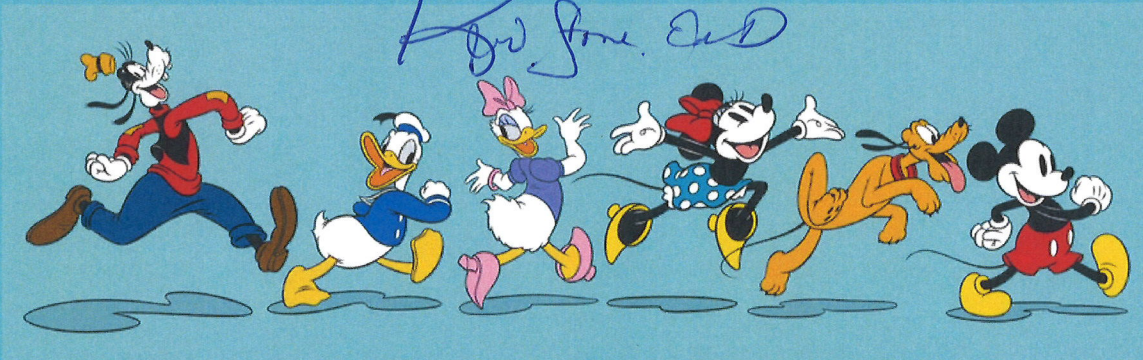

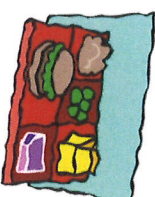

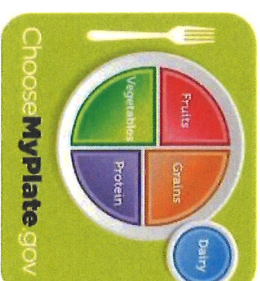
