


Action Steps		
1	Focus on unpacking standards and developing and utilizing success criteria during instruction (developing I Can statements)	
2	More frequent check ins during dept. meetings to make sure teachers understand the standards	
3	Update walkthrough tool to include whether teacher references I can statements during instruction	
4	Challenging teachers to take it to the next level (get out of Costas level one)	

Cycle 2: Anticipated Outcomes

Anticipated Outcomes (Educators)	Anticipated Outcomes (Students)
Teachers better understand standards and can describe them in student friendly "I Can statements"	Student interview data should show an increase in the number of students who can tell you what they're learning today
Better structured, higher rigorous lessons utilizing school wide strategies	Students know the expectation/instructions for schoolwide strategies and can transfer over from classroom to classroom
Teaching bell to bell by including engagement strategies	Student data, iReady, and common assessments will show improvement.
