9163 SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT FOR INTERSCHOLASTIC EVENTS (M)

The Board of Directors promotes a physically and emotionally safe and healthy playing environment at interscholastic events and insists good sportsmanship be exhibited at all times by student athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators at such events.

The New Jersey State Interscholastic Athletic Association (NJSIAA) requires the Board of member districts to establish policies and procedures relating to sportsmanship and to identify responsibilities of administrators, coaches, and students to ensure their observance. The NJSIAA requires the member Boards to adopt a Spectator Code of Conduct Policy for all spectators attending an interscholastic event.

The local districts' high school(s) may be member school of the NJSIAA. The NJSIAA and the local Boards require high standards of courtesy, fair play, and sportsmanship be featured at school district and NJSIAA interscholastic events. Unsportsmanlike conduct by a person at an event shall subject the individual to disciplinary action.

The commission will enforce any disciplinary action issued by the local Board.
