Take a Campus Tour.
 Access Going Merry for a list of all scholarships.
 Attend college fairs and college planning events.
☐ Narrow down your college list (Reach, Probable, Foundation).
\square Create an organizational system to track college and scholarship application deadlines and details.
Early Fall (September-October)
☐ Make an appointment with Mrs. Campbell for your Senior Meeting.
☐ October 15-17: Free Colorado Application Days. Visit the College Center.
☐ Decide how you will apply to each school: Early Decision, Early Action, or Regular Decision.
☐ Know the essay prompts for each college you apply to and begin drafts.
☐ Update your Naviance account with "college I'm applying to."
Begin college applications (Institutional applications or Common Applications).
☐ Link your Naviance and Common App accounts if using the Common App.
Advocate for yourself and ask questions.
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Winter/Spring
☐ Receive and compare college financial aid award packages. Contact colleges with any questions. Ask if there are additional scholarships you can apply for or qualify for.

May 1st is College Decision Day- the day to let your college know you are attending.

 Take AP Exams and request AP scores be sent to the college you will attend.
 Request Final Transcripts.
