Fairview Feedback Form Update

Some of our parents have indicated some questions and concerns around the cell phone holders in classrooms and how our teachers

are using them. To clarify, we do encourage our teachers to use the cell phone holders as part of a standard classroom routine for a variety of reasons. Our teachers do have the autonomy to use their professional judgment regarding whether or not cell phones are used in their classrooms for instructional purposes. However, our teachers should not be using cell phones for attendance purposes. We have communicated to our teachers that this practice is to be discontinued. Please, let me know if there are continued concerns about this practice. Away for the Day does not mean that students do not have access to cell phones nor does it mean that our students won't use their cell phones during the day for instructional purposes. Our greatest change here at Fairview regarding cell phones is not what is occurring in our classrooms, but rather what happens with cell phones during passing periods, free periods, and lunch. Phones should be put away during these times. Again, students may be asked to place cell phones in holders in our classrooms and our students may be using cell phones as part of a lesson.

Attendance Correction Process for Discrepancies

If your student was marked absent but was present in class, they can address the discrepancy by using an Attendance Correction Slip (Oops Slip). To start the process, students should visit the attendance desk in the front office to obtain the slip. They'll need to present it to their teacher, who will review and correct the attendance as needed. Once the teacher signs off, the student should return the slip to the attendance desk to update the record. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in ensuring accurate attendance records!



Important Reminder:

Once a student has been excused 10 times, documentation will be required to excuse any further absences.




Student Conduct
