Fees are reviewed on an annual basis and any changes are usually announced in the Lent Term, with effect from the following Autumn Term (September).

***Reduced fees are not applicable for those that have paid in advance.**

SUPPLEMENTARY ITEMS

Visa /CAS administration fee:

The fee for the administration of the CAS sponsorship for pupils requiring a visa for study, whether for a day or boarding place is £400 + VAT per term.

Breakfast and Supper Clubs:

- Breakfast club is open to non-boarders Monday-Friday at 7.30am at a charge of £4.50/day (exempt from VAT).
- Supper club is open to non-boarders Monday-Friday at 6pm at a charge of £5.50/day (exempt from VAT).
- Both the above can be booked on an ad-hoc (24 hours' notice) or termly basis via schoolsec@aldro.org

**Music and Lamda:**

Music and Lamda lessons - £220 per term (ten lessons), Music theory lessons - £5 per 30-minute group lesson. These items are normally invoiced direct by the teacher concerned, except where lessons are given by our full-time members of staff. Instruments can be hired from school at a rate of £35/term. Where invoiced by the school, VAT will apply. Terms and conditions for lessons are set by individual visiting teachers, notice for a cancellation of music lessons, Lamda lessons and instrument hire is half a term and should be emailed directly to the appropriate teacher. Form 3's will not start lessons until January.

1:1 Learning Support:

£370 + VAT per term for 1:1 lessons (per subject – 30 minutes) based on 10 lessons. This item will appear on the termly bill in arrears. One term's notice in writing is required.

EAL (English as an additional language):

Individual EAL/French lessons are available for pupils requiring support, with a termly charge of £485 + VAT. Group French lessons are available, with a termly charge of £355 + VAT.

Tennis:

Group Coaching:	£115 per term
Individual Coaching:	£225 per term

Parents are invoiced direct by the tennis coach (no VAT is then applicable) who will notify parents in advance of any increase. One term's notice in writing is required (please see Information Booklet).

Minibus Travel:

The school operates a morning bus route on Monday – Fridays during term time, which is bookable per term. The cost varies from £3.50 - £6 per trip depending on the stop chosen and is invoiced via your termly bill in arrears (exempt from VAT).

Miscellaneous:

There are also some optional activities which may incur charges (for example Design Technology, Chess, fencing, horse-riding, shooting, MTech, Martin Bicknell Cricket Academy and Phillipa Hogan School of Dance lessons) Boarders' Sunday outings are charged according to the activity entrance fees only where applicable. Matrons' charge for toiletries, shoelaces, etc., are calculated strictly in accordance with normal retail prices and charged in arrears. Items billed by the school will be subject to VAT. Items billed by the supplier direct may not be subject to VAT.

Breakages:

Where pupils are responsible for damage or breakage of school property as a result of misbehaviour or ill-treatment, replacement or repair charges, plus labour where applicable, will appear on the fee bill. Parents will be notified of larger commitments.

Deposits:

A deposit of £1,000 for UK permanent residents or £11,400 for non-permanent residents (one term's boarding fee) is payable with the completion of the Acceptance form (VAT is not applicable). The deposit is refundable after the payment of the final invoice at Aldro.

Bursaries

The Governors of Aldro are committed to broad access to the school by offering to eligible parents, means-tested financial support with the payment of school fees. Such support may be awarded in the form of a discount of up to 100% on tuition fees payable, depending on the financial, compassionate or other pertinent circumstances of applicants. Bursary awards are subject to repeat testing of parental means each year and may be varied upwards or downwards, depending on parental circumstances.

Additional Assistance

In addition to means-tested bursaries, Aldro also offers the following additional assistance.

- **Armed Forces:** a discount for boarding places to the value of 20% is available to current serving members of the armed forces.
- **Staff:** a discount is available for current members of staff. Staff may also be eligible for a mean-tested bursary if they are not able to afford the residual fees after a staff discount has been applied.
- **Clergy:** a discount of 20% is available to those in full-time Christian ministry.
- **Siblings:** When three children attend simultaneously a sibling discount of 20% for the youngest child will be applicable.

In addition to the School's bursary fund, there are a number of educational and charitable trusts which provide assistance with tuition fees. In the majority of cases, these are to assist children who are already attending a fee paying school and due to a change of circumstances may be unable to remain. Aldro School encourages parents/guardians to apply for support where it is felt a good case can be made for assistance. Fees in Advance

The fees in advance scheme requires a minimum of at least two years' (6 terms) fees in advance, and increments of one year's fees thereafter, up to the maximum six years (18 terms) at Aldro. The discount rate for the Scheme is set by the Governors each year and the scheme year is 1 September to 31 August (the academic year).
