
Join us this winter for furthering your equine education and experiences. Lou takes students into the classroom for some equine education necessary for the thriving equestrian, along with hands on experiences.

Stay connected all winter long with our Bowers Riding School students and local equestrian enthusiasts with this fun, interactive classroom course. An excellent balance of science based classroom work and hands on horse activities.



This introductory horse camp includes handson activities with the horses while learning the
basics of horse behavior, anatomy, and care. It
will foster strong relationships between
campers and horses, and give campers the
skills needed to create these relationships in
the future. After this camp, participants will







DIVERSE LEARNERS' DAYS

This specialized program is designed for children with special needs to provide a more accessible experience for the child and their family who might be hesitant to visit due to a child's complex learning needs or challenges (i.e. sensory needs/responses, language, emotional or social concerns, cognitive learning challenges, physical needs, etc.). During this collaborative program, the guide will work directly with the children (4:1 ratio) to provide specialized instruction and accommodation with animals, gardens, and farm/nature activities.


