There are some changes to our registration process this year. Instead of paper registration forms, students will complete their Course Registration through StudentVue under the “Course Request” tab.

**Parents:** We ask that after your student completes their online course request, that you review their selections and “Lock-In” your student’s course requests through ParentVue. This indicates your approval of the selected courses and, in the case of Honors and AP courses, agree to our Honors Academic Agreement. On the Course Request page, the parent will select the “Lock Course Requests” button – this is located on the right-hand side of the screen. After this is complete, students and parents can no longer make changes to the course request page.

### Other Schedule Considerations

<b>Seminary</b> - Takes up a period in your schedule but is not eligible for credit, students schedules will show "Release Time"
<b>Release Period</b> - 12th graders can take up to 2 release periods if they are on track for graduation. Keep in mind that Seniors must take at least 4 credit-bearing classes.
<b>EVIT</b> - 11th and 12th graders can concurrently enroll at EVIT. EVIT will take up 3 class periods each year and students will need to ensure they still meet all graduation requirements.
<b>Middle School Credit</b> - If you earned high school credit in middle school, this will count towards your elective requirements. You will still have to take 4 years of math in high school.

### Reminders

When selecting your classes in StudentVue, make sure you select the 1st and 2nd semester section of the course (unless it is a semester-only class).

Seniors, you can add release time to your schedule, please make sure to select the sections that correspond to the periods you wish to have free.

Some classes may not be visible during online registration as they require auditions, portfolios, or teacher approval, please sign up for the beginning level course and the teacher will move you to the appropriate level.

EVIT students, please make sure to select each section of AM or PM EVIT **3** times to block off 3 periods for EVIT.
