 - Provides extensive information on school and district staff, programs, and student demographics

 - Students who did not pass in 2023 but achieved approaches or higher scores in 2024. This is based only on the grades and contents that we have growth metrics.

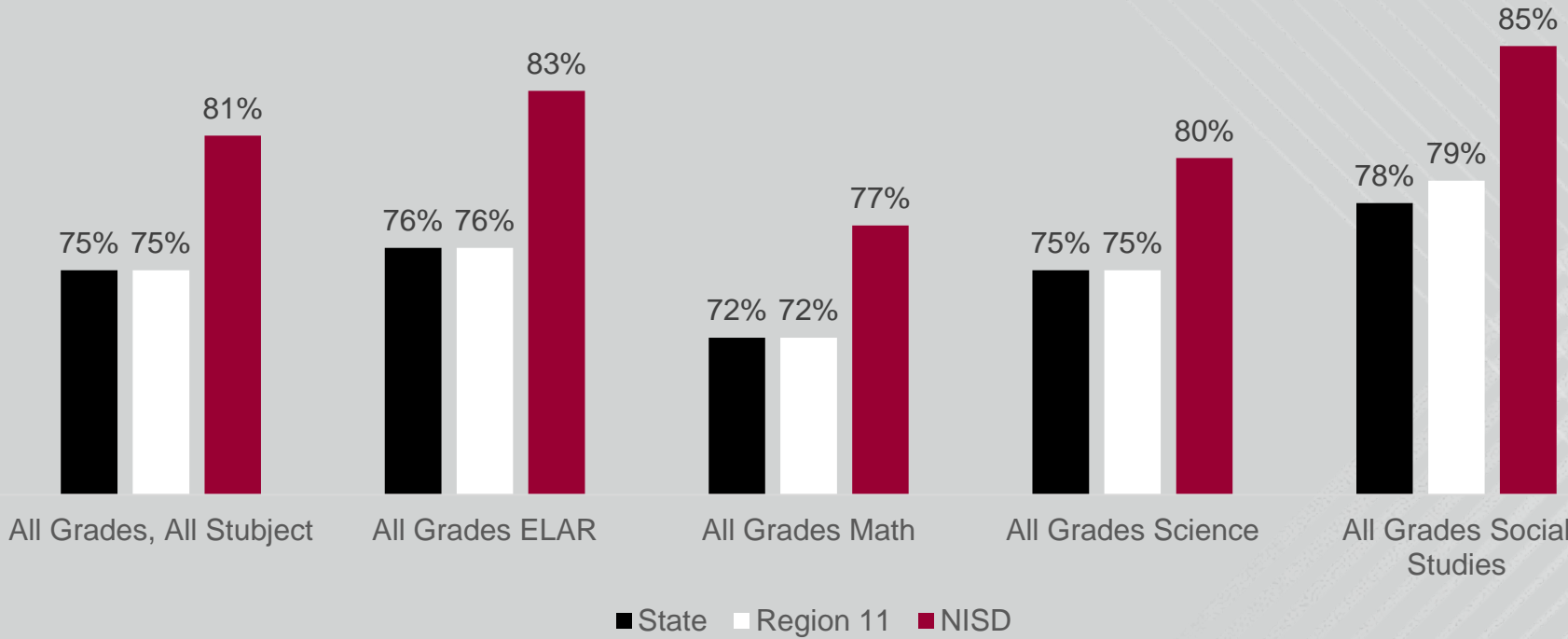

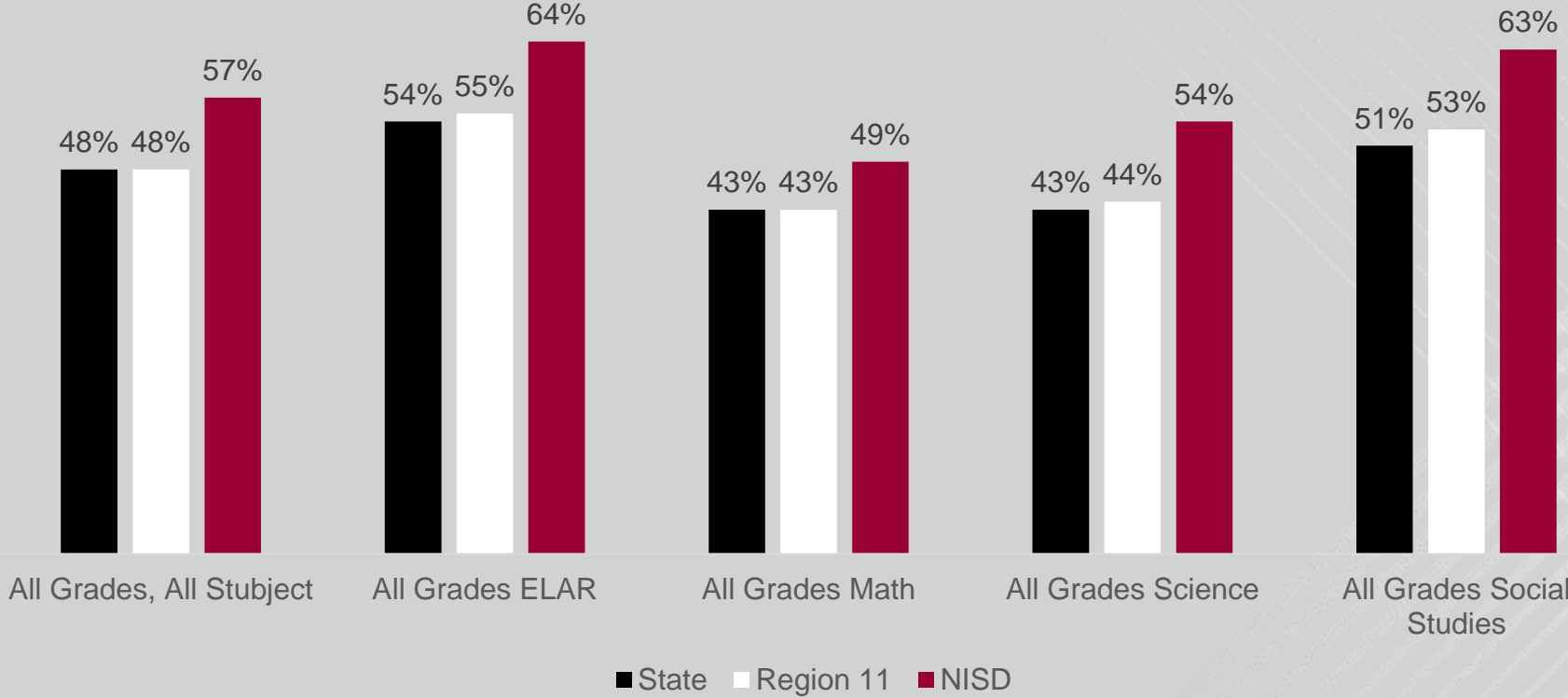

 - 2024 – participation rate of 99%



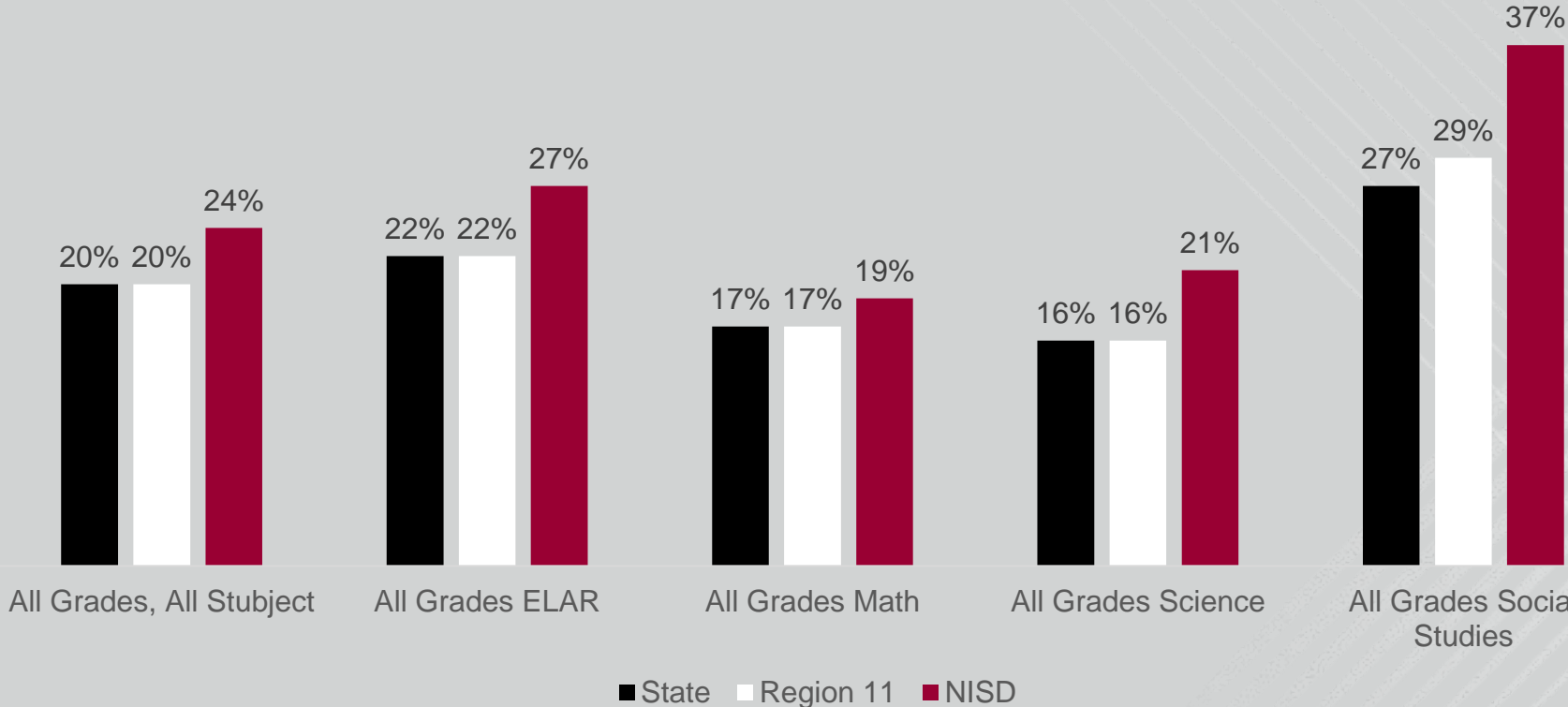
In 2024, a higher percentage of NISD students scored at the Approaches level or higher than the state and Region 11 in all content areas.



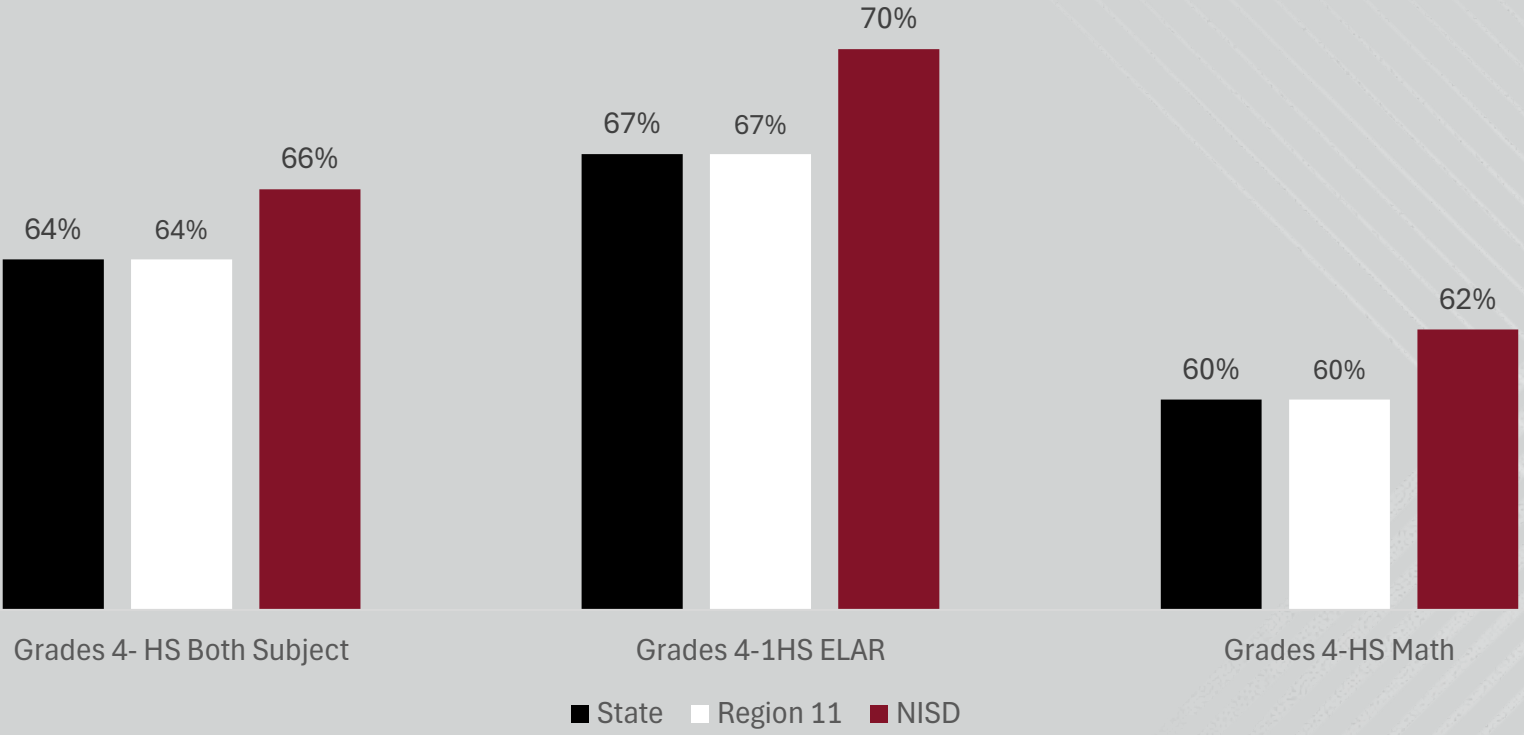
In 2024, a higher percentage of NISD students scored at the Meets level or higher than the state and Region 11 on all content areas.

In 2024, NISD outperformed the state and Region 11 growth.

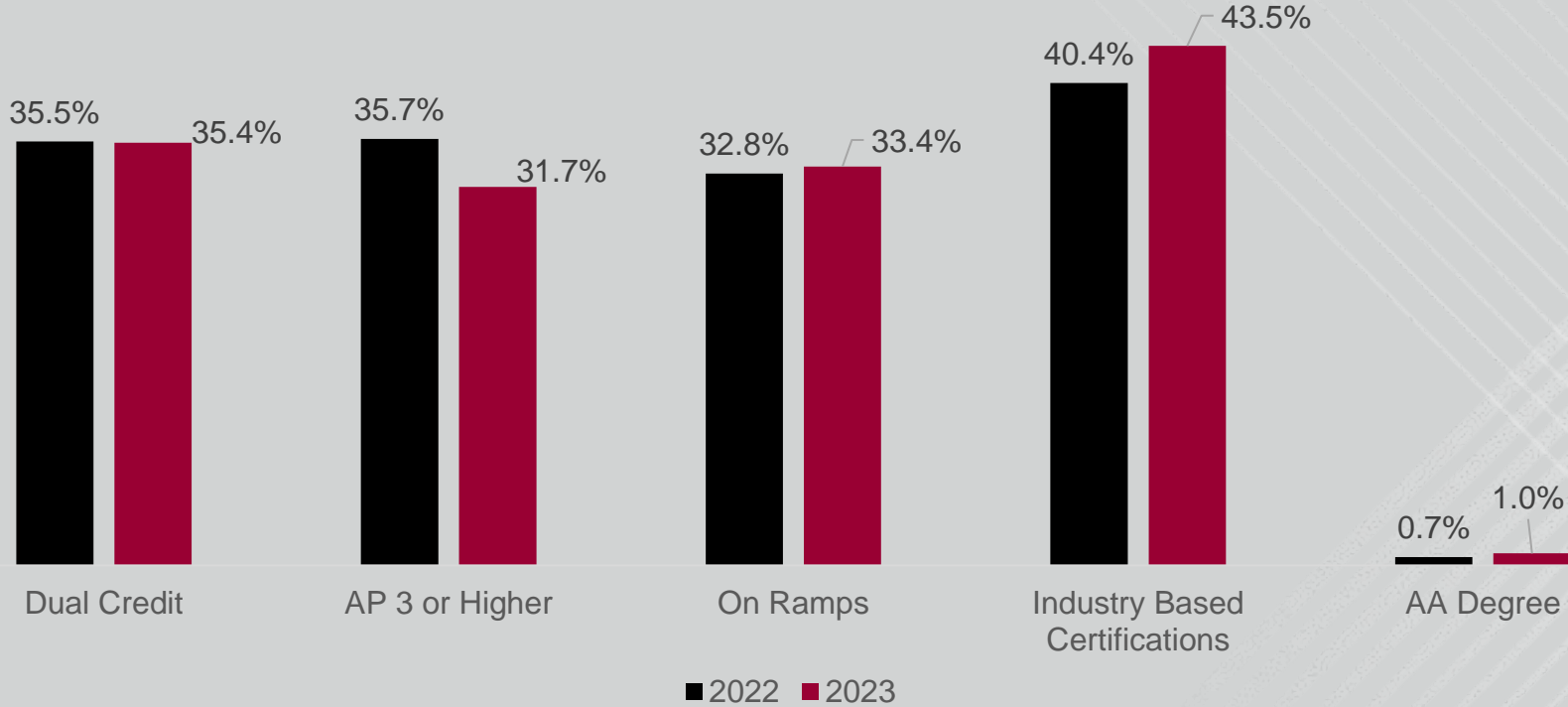

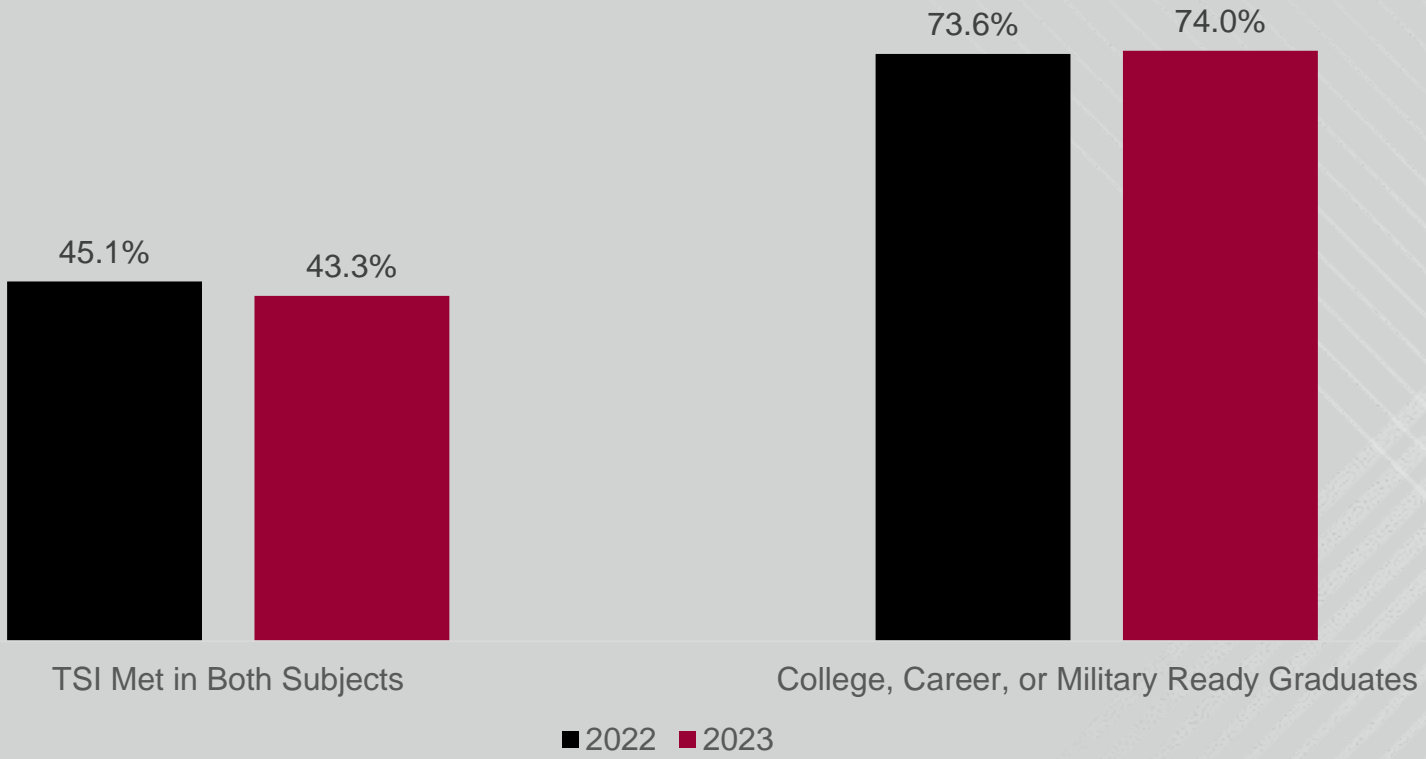

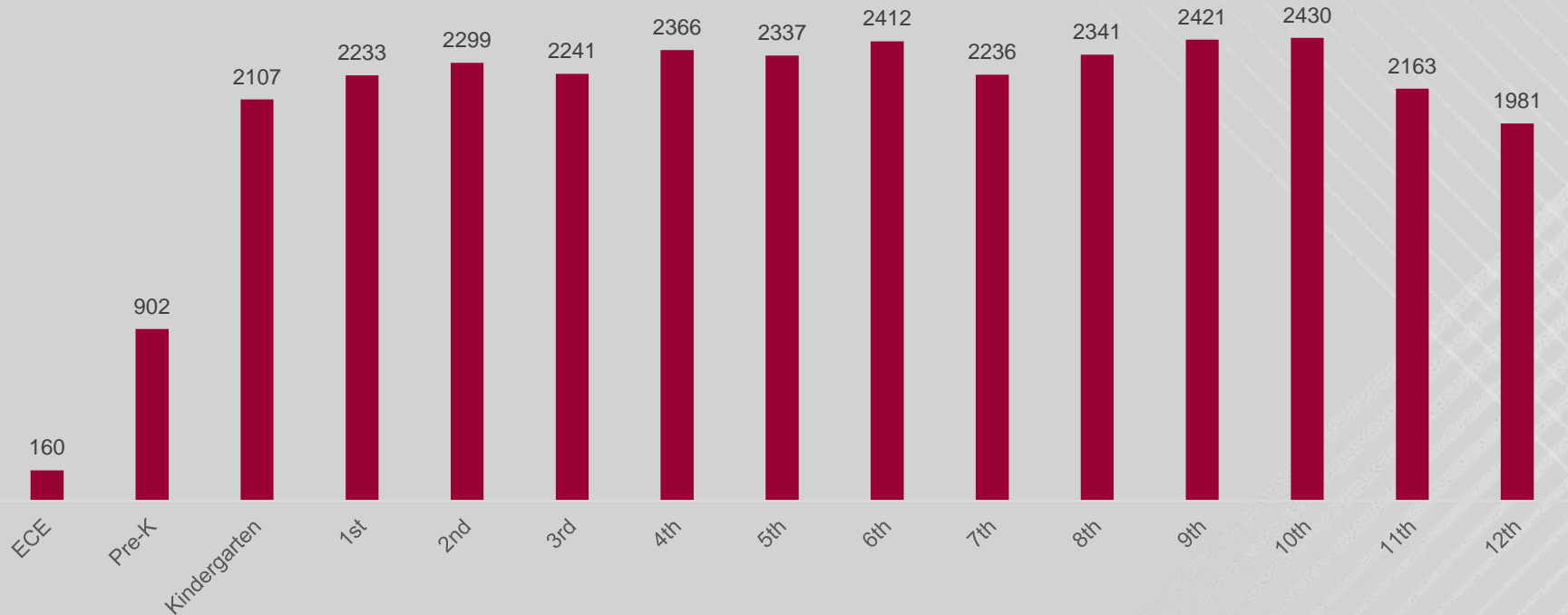

What is the 2022-23 District Accreditation Status?

- Generally, each year TEA assigns one of four accreditation statuses to each district in the state:
 1. *Accredited*
 2. *Accredited-Warning*
 3. *Accredited-Probation*
 4. *Not Accredited-Revoked*
- In assigning an accreditation status to a district, TEA considers
 - Academic accountability ratings
 - Financial accountability ratings
 - Data integrity
 - Program-area deficiencies identified through Results Driven Accountability (RDA)
- The District's 2022-23 Accreditation Status is: **Accredited**

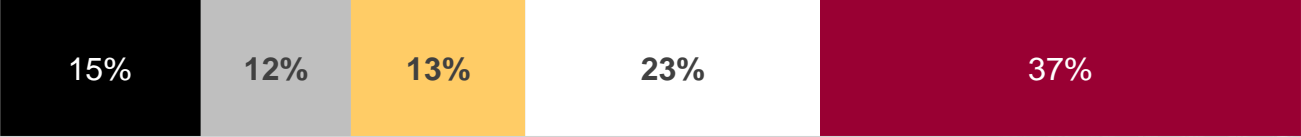


The most current year we have on student performance in Texas colleges is the class of 22. 766 of 1776 graduates attended a Texas two- or four-year college.
