Lil' Rams

Lil' Rams program includes children with birth year 2021. Registration fee \$25 and includes a T-shirt. Registration will be open 1/1/25 - 2/14/25. There will be no late fee for Lil' Rams but please register early as space is limited.

In-House

Our In-house program includes **U6** (birth years 2019/2020), **U8** (birth years 2017/2018), and **U10** (birth years 2015/2016). Registration fee \$75. This fee does not include uniforms. Regular registration will be open 1/1/25 - 1/31/25. Late registration will be 2/1/25 - 2/14/25 and will include a late fee of \$25.

Travel

Our Travel program includes **U10** (birth years 2015/2016), **U12** (birth years 2013/2014), and **U14** (birth years 2011/2012). Registration fee \$110. This fee does not include uniform cost. Registration will be open 1/1/25 – 1/31/25. There is **NO LATE REGISTRATION for TRAVEL** so you must register by 1/31/25.

TOPSoccer

TOPSoccer is a national outreach soccer program for children with physical, mental, intellectual, and behavioral special needs. TOPSoccer is open to **birth years 2013- 2020** in the Ringgold area as well as all surrounding **communities**. Registration fee \$35 and includes a T-shirt. Registration will be open 1/1/25-2/14/25. There will be no late fee for this program. Please see our TOPSoccer Flyer or email us for more information.

U10/U12 Practice Only Option

The practice only program is for our multisport athletes who would like to keep working and improving on their soccer skills but who cannot commit to a full season schedule due to other sports. This program is available to U10 & U12 (birth years 2013 – 2016) players only and will consist of one weekly practice. These players will not be participating in games and will not require a uniform. Registration fee is \$35 and will be open 1/1/25 – 1/31/25.
