Family Literacy Activities

Letter Hunt

Go on a scavenger hunt around the house for items starting with a specific letter.



Texture Letters

Create letters with different textured materials. Examples: fabric or sandpaper



Letter Relay

Collect several objects around your home. Have a race to pick up items that start with a specific letter.



Letter Exchange

Exchange letters with family members or friends and share words starting with them.



Online Storytime

Join virtual storytime sessions. Check out your local library or Google to find virtual offerings.



Rhyming Games

Create word rhymes with everyday objects. See who can make the most rhymes. Example: Spoon- Moon

Smell & Spell

Identify objects in your home or outside by their smell and spell them out loud.

Alphabet Puppet Show

Create puppets for letters and perform a show. Encourage your child to use words that begin with that letter as much as possible.

I Love You Letters

Share words that you love starting with specific letters at dinner. Share why you love that word.

Letter Cookie Baking

Bake seasonal treats shaped like letters. Roll and cut cookie dough to form letters or words.
