CCRPI

- Dr. Harrison explained College and Career Reading Performance Index (CCRPI)
 - Compared 2023 – 2024
 - Highlighted: Liberty ES showed an increase in Content Mastery Score and maintained Progress Performance above a 90.
 - 12/12/2024 – played recording of board meeting discussion about CCRPI results by Dr. Heath (Chief Officer of Academics & Accountability)
