## **SMSD LIBRARIES UPDATE**



SMSD Libraries are dedicated to promoting literacy and fostering a lifelong love of reading by increasing book checkouts across all campuses. Here's a comparison of circulation numbers from this year (Aug-Nov 2024) vs. the entire 2023-2024 (August to May) school year:

Early Childhood Center: 771 books this year, surpassing last year's total of 726.

**Stafford Elementary:** A remarkable increase with 6,768 books this year, compared to 1,605 last year.

**Stafford Middle School:** 1,781 books checked out so far this year, compared to 8,809 last year.

**Stafford High School:** 2,044 books this year, nearly matching last year's 2,195.

These numbers highlight our efforts to engage students and support their reading journeys!


