AP Exam Pass Rate Increase

The # of AISD students taking AP exams has increased over the last 3 years and so has the pass rate.

21-22:

1541 exams, 64% pass rate

22-23:

1765 exams, 64% pass rate

23-24:

1798 exams, 66% pass rate

Weatherford College Dual Credit Enrollment Costs Down

AISD has around 100 students enrolled in Weatherford College Dual Credit courses each year, and we are excited that, with WC opting into FAST, tuition for a 3-credit course will drop from \$380 to \$171, making this a very affordable option!

High AP Test Pass Rate

Most colleges grant credit for scores of 3 or above on AP tests. Each of the last three years, AISD has had more than 63% of students earn a 3+ on AP exams:

2021: 67% with 3+ score

2022: 65% with 3+ score

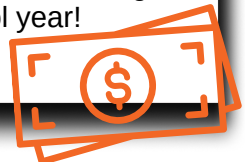
2023: 64% with 3+ score

Money Saved for Families!

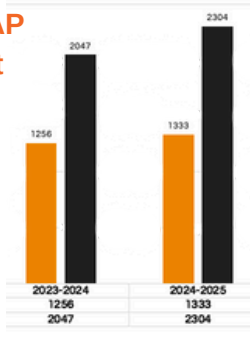

In 2024-2025, 1,333 Aledo High School students are taking 2,304 Advanced Placement courses.

UT OnRamps Enrollment Up

Since 21-22, student enrollment in UT OnRamps continues to rise (347 students enrolled in 388 courses in 21-22 to 589 students enrolled in 667 courses in 24-25). Each year, at least 89% of OnRamps students were eligible for the college credit.
