When motivated, high-potential students actively connect with their learning, their peers, and their teachers through AVID's research-based curriculum, a world of possibility opens--both now and in the future!

What AVID Elective isn't...

AVID is not a remedial program; It is designed to challenge students and prepare them for success in rigorous coursework. AVID is also not individual tutoring; Instead, it focuses on equipping students with the inquiry-based tools and strategies they need to identify and work through challenges they encounter in their core classes, both independently and with their peers.
