Safe, Engaged Students Achieving at High Levels

Goal: To enhance the overall educational experience and foster a positive, high-performing school culture by systematically evaluating and improving the effectiveness of curriculum, instruction, and assessment, while actively supporting staff professional development and engagement.

Action Items:

- Curricular Alignment conduct a district-wide, systematic review of core curriculum (ELA, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies) to ensure alignment of curriculum, assessments, and instruction to the PA Standards.
- 2. **Co-teaching Model** implement co-teaching pilot for delivery of special education services.
- 3. Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) Continue implementation of MTSS at all schools.
- 4. Instructional Coaching Continue implementation of instructional coaching model.
- 5. **Project Management** Continue to improve safety/security and operations through effective implementation and management of new and existing systems.
- 6. **Communication** Develop additional opportunities to sustain engagement staff, students, and community members.
