DRIVE 2025– Raffle Ticket Sales Instructions

Catholic Central is excited to announce our 72nd annual DRIVE raffle. This is a fun time where students can take a break from the rigors of second semester, earn days off, and most importantly, raise money for a very important cause. The purpose of the DRIVE raffle is to provide funding for our Tuition Assistance Program. Without this funding, many of our families would not be able to attend Catholic Central. In support of tuition assistance, we ask that the family of each student sell the established quota in order to reach our financial goal. Noted below are the 2025 DRIVE raffle details and several important notes. If you have any questions, please feel free to call the Business Office at any time.

RAFFLE DETAILS: 2025

- Ticket Price \$10.00
- Quota \$150.00 (3 books of 5 tickets). The family of each student will receive a packet with 15 raffle tickets per student. Additional quantities may be obtained through your son's homeroom teacher.
- When selling tickets, the purchasers must be at least 18 years old to buy raffle tickets. However, an adult may put a minor's name on the ticket stub and prizes may be awarded to a minor.
- Cash or checks made out to <u>Catholic Central High School</u> are both acceptable forms of payment. Money is to be turned in to the student's homeroom teacher each morning during the days of the DRIVE: February 14-21 and February 24, 2025.
- All sold ticket stubs and unsold tickets **must** be returned to the school on the scheduled **return dates** (March 4 and March 11, 2025).
- The raffle drawing will take place on April 29, 2025, at 2:00PM. The winner does not need to be present to win. The prizes include:

1 st Prize	\$ 30,000.00
2 nd Prize	\$ 15,000.00
3 rd Prize	\$ 10,000.00
4 th Prize	\$ 5,000.00
5 th Prize	\$ 5,000.00

PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Each family is responsible for returning ticket stubs and the corresponding amount of money. All unsold tickets must also be returned. Lost or stolen tickets not returned to the school are considered to be purchased by the family and will be billed to the student's tuition account.
- 2. Families who purchase tickets on behalf of other parties (fronted cash for future reimbursement) are responsible for the collection of those funds. Catholic Central cannot cash subsequent "reimbursement" checks that a family has collected. The family must have the buyer reissue the check in the name of the family.

- 3. Please complete <u>all</u> the required information on the ticket stub. Sellers must ensure that the buyer information on the ticket stub is legible with the correct name, address, and phone number.
- 4. Specific tickets (with serial numbers) are assigned to each family by student. Please <u>do not</u> exchange or trade unsold books of tickets between other CC families or sons.
- 5. Money (cash or check) should be collected at the time of the sale. The buyer must be given the "tear-off" ticket from the bound ticket book. Please leave sold ticket stubs in the original bound book.
- 6. Sales of tickets are non-refundable.
- 7. Please note that it is illegal to mail tickets through the U.S. postal service.
- 8. If a family does not meet quota, the student will be required to attend school on the scheduled DRIVE days off.

X- Series Tickets (optional): The Business Office will issue a separate series of tickets called the X-Series. This set of tickets is reserved for large single purchasers of DRIVE tickets (\$250 or more). The primary benefit of these tickets is that the student is not required to complete the buyer information on the ticket stubs. Here's how it works:

- 1. Single buyer check is brought into the Business Office (before the start of school).
- 2. Business Office will complete an X-Series Voucher indicating **the buyer's information** and the assigned ticket numbers.
- 3. Student is given the separated tickets for return to the ticket buyer.
- 4. Student is given a copy of the voucher to return to his homeroom for credit of ticket sales.
- 5. Business Office will keep the assigned ticket stubs for inclusion in the raffle drawing.

PLEASE NOTE: The X-Series of tickets is optional. It is intended to reduce the amount of time required to complete ticket stubs for large ticket buyers. If you choose, large quantities of tickets may still be obtained through the student's homeroom. It is important to note when utilizing the X-Series Ticket option that the check must be brought in prior to the buyer receiving tickets. The Business Office can only assign tickets to one buyer per check. **Please obtain all relevant buyer information before requesting X-Series tickets** (buyer name, address, phone number).
