## HIGH SCHOOL APPLICATION PROCESS & ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

### COMPLETE YOUR APPLICATION

- Complete an online application at [uanola.org/admissions/apply](https://uanola.org/admissions/apply)
  - The Archdiocesan high school application (“white card”) for incoming 8th graders is available November 13, 2024.
  - Applications for all other grade levels are open now for the 2025-2026 school year.
- Submit the non-refundable application fee.
- Provide the past three years of academic records and standardized test scores (including signed release request).
- A grade-level screening is required for each applicant.

### TESTING AND INTERVIEWS

- All testing and screenings will be scheduled on Ursuline’s campus upon receipt of a completed application.
  - MAP® Testing (required) - January 11, 2025
  - Interview (required) - January 15, 2025
  - Scholarship Testing (optional) - January 25, 2025

### ADMISSIONS REVIEW AND DECISION

All admissions decisions are made by the Ursuline Academy Admissions Committee, which is comprised of members of the Ursuline Academy of New Orleans Administrative Team.

Decisions made by the Admissions Committee will be communicated both electronically and in writing by the Admissions Office.

Letters of acceptance for first-round High School applicants will be communicated February 27, 2025.

Financial assistance and scholarship awards/opportunities will be included in the acceptance packet.

Rolling admission after the first round is based on space availability.
