



# Course Selection Roadmap






# Freshman Schedule

- 5. Elective 1: World Language (recommended)
- 6. Elective 2: Fine art or applied academic
- 7. Ethnic Studies/Health (optional this year)



Students in the Fremont Union High School District are allowed to select <u>six courses</u> in the initial registration process and may indicate a seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) class to be added <u>if space is available</u>. Students will <u>not be allowed to "double up"</u> in any one curriculum area in their first six choices. After all initial course requests are filled, students will be placed in their requested seventh class if space allows. It is critical that initial choices be made carefully since changing these choices at a later date may not be possible.


Choose classes wisely! Once classes are assigned, there is rarely space in other classes to allow for level changes.

# AVID at Fremont High School


#### **Next Steps**
