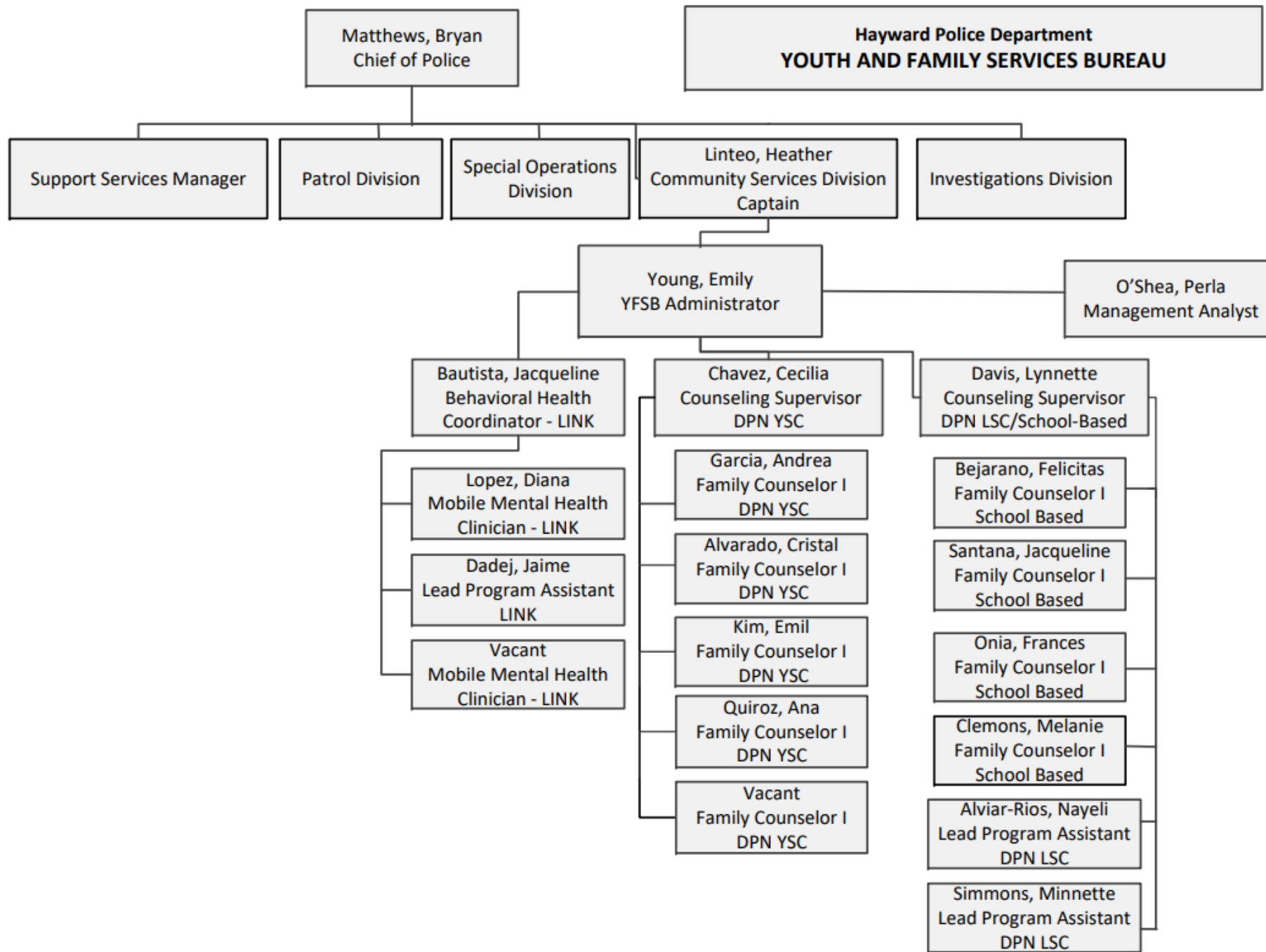

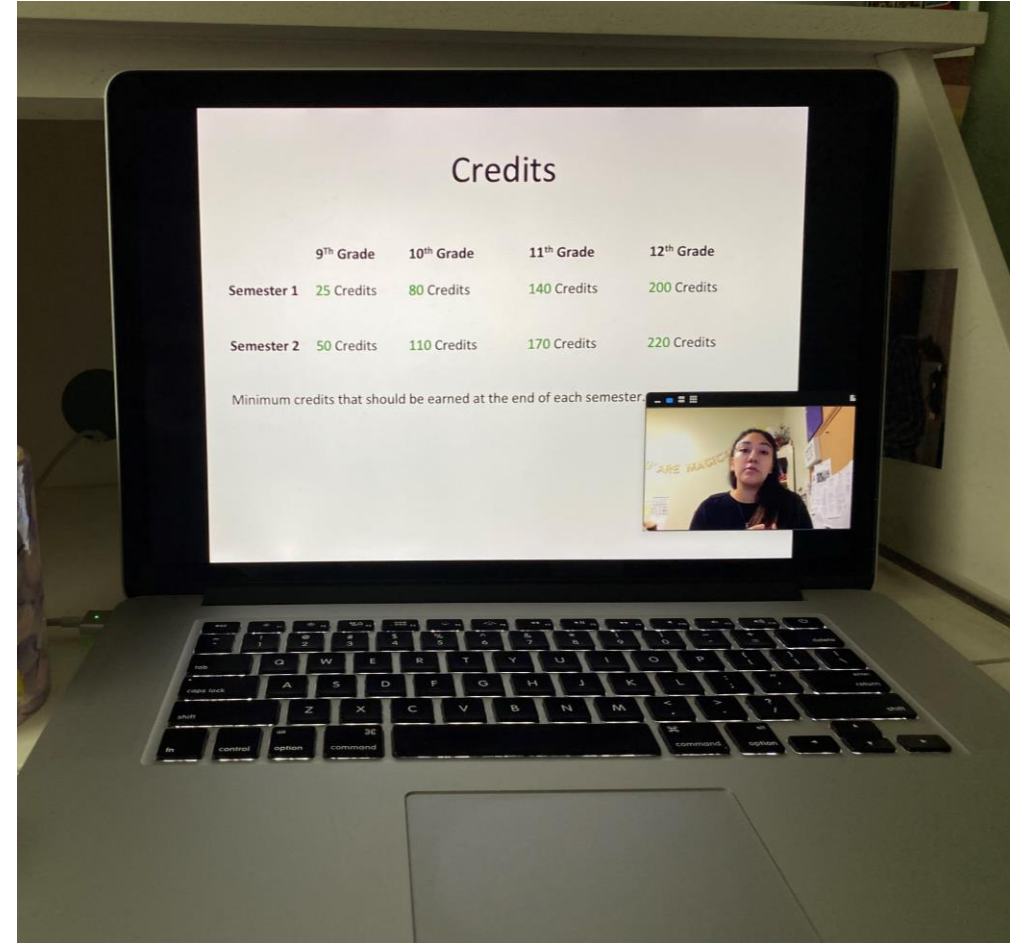
Free Mental Health Services for Hayward

- Crisis Intervention, Case Management, and Family Counseling
- 5 Masters and Doctoral level clinicians, most licensed
- Youth at high risk of involvement in the juvenile justice system and their families.
- Malabar House coverage
- Approximately 300 youth served annually



Diversion, Life Skills, and Restorative Justice

- NTA Diversion, Life Skills Workshops, Restorative Justice groups for youth.
- Service started in September 2019 to fill identified gaps
- 2 Service Coordinators
- Approximately 115 youth served annually



Mental Health Crisis Intervention



- Critical incident response
- Walk-in crisis counseling
- Suicide/homicide assessment

School Based Mental Health Services

- Focus on school climate and the social emotional learning needs of all students
- 4 Masters and Doctoral level clinicians, most licensed
- Most Hayward schools served
 - Direct service at 4 sites
 - COST Participation at all middle and high schools
 - Crisis response at all schools

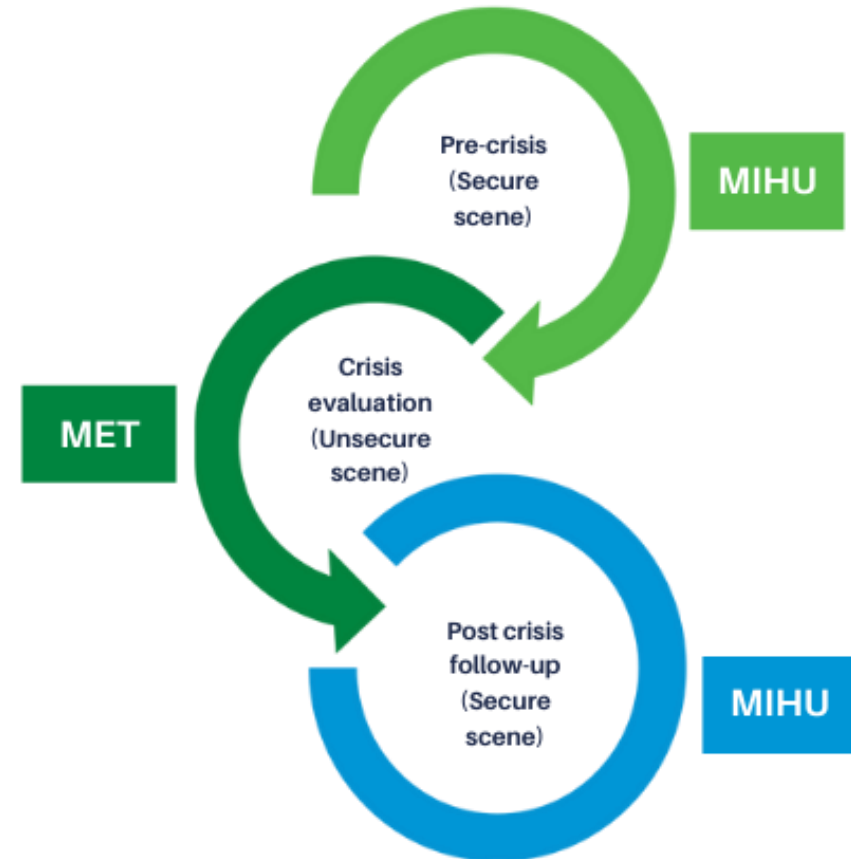
Working Differently to Serve Families

- Social services embedded in HPD prevent crime through addressing root causes
- YFSB designed to promote safety and keep youth out of the system
- Students need to feel safe for instruction to happen



Hayward Evaluation and Response Teams (HEART)

- Innovative new program to serve community members experiencing mental illness, substance abuse and homelessness
- Linking people with services and reducing the need for police officers to intervene
- Piloting two different mobile teams
- Partnership between City, County and Community Based Organizations
