Recommended Ballot Language

For FY 2026 per H.887

Article #1 (School Budget):

Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expend \$67,187,000, which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year?

The Rutland City School District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil education spending of \$12,197, which is 1.7% lower than per pupil spending for the current year."



Messages for FY 2026

- RCPS total expenses projected to increase by 5.2%.
- Per pupil education spending as defined by AOE drops by 1.7%.
- Number of funded full-time positions remains near FY 2025 levels.
- Budget includes:
 - o BGT upgrades for operations continuity and safety.
 - Funding to begin a district-wide phone system replacement and upgrade.
