GENERAL COMMITTEE REPORT TUESDAY, APRIL 12, 2016

The St. Bernard Parish School Board met as a Committee of the Whole on Tuesday, April 12, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the St. Bernard Parish School Board Office. Following the Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance, the Secretary called the roll. Members present were, Mrs. Diana B. Dysart, President, Mrs. Darleen P. Asevedo, Mr. Donald D. Campbell, Dr. Hugh C. Craft, Mr. Clifford M. Englande, Mrs. Katherine K. Lemoine, Dr. Henderson Lewis, Jr., Mr. Joseph V. Long, Sr., Mrs. Judy W. Nicosia and Mr. Sean K. Warner. Mr. William H. Egan was absent.

On a point of privilege, Mr. Clifford Englande thanked the voting public for their support and passage of re-dedicated millages to be used for the upkeep of school properties. He also thanked Ms. Voitier for her hard work in promoting the passage of the millages. Mrs. Dysart echoed that sentiment. Ms. Voitier reiterated that this will not be additional millages, only a re-dedicating of existing millages which means there will be no raise in taxes for the public.

Mrs. Dysart, on behalf of the Board, wished Mr. Englande a Happy Birthday.

Mr. Warner also took a moment to commend the CHS baseball team who won a recent game against Holy Cross High School. Mr. Warner stated that the win was great but even better was the fact that the game was televised and the announcers had so many good things to say about St. Bernard Parish, it's community, the facilities at Chalmette High, the educational program, etc.

Mrs. Dysart began the meeting by welcoming Ms. Lauren Faust and Mr. Wayne Burgess of the LSU Ag Center who appeared before the Committee to review last year's Ag Center contributions and the upcoming Ag Magic Presentation. Mr. Burgess explained some of the contributions to the schools during the previous year which include club activities, educational meetings and end of the year field trips. He then showed a short film about last year's Ag Magic Program which took place at the Meraux Foundation's Docville Farm. The dates for the official student presentation of AG Magic are Wednesday, May 4, 2016 through Friday, May 6, 2016. The exhibits will be open to the public on Saturday, May 7, 2016. Admission is free. Mr. Burgess thanked the Committee and volunteers from St. Bernard for their support in this undertaking.

After all questions and comments were addressed, the Committee thanked Ms. Faust and Mr. Burgess for their presentation.

Mrs. Dysart turned the meeting over to Superintendent Voitier who explained that the next agenda item is presented to recognize the required hours of training for all School Board members. She stated that the certificates in their packet shows that each Board Member has received the required training in accordance with ACT 705 passed by the Louisiana Legislature in 2010 which requires six (6) hours of continuing education annually. All training topics were presented by the Louisiana School Boards Association and the Louisiana Board of Ethics. These certificates will be published within the minutes of the Regular Monthly Meeting of the Board.





As Education Committee Chair, Mrs. Dysart next welcomed Ms. Jessica Vallelungo who is in charge of the Career and Technical Education Program at Chalmette High School.

Ms. Vallelungo shared with the Committee an update on the Career and Technical Programs at Chalmette High School. She first mentioned that currently there are 50 additional students in dual enrollment credit courses at Chalmette High and Nunez Community College as compared to last semester for a total of 161 students. She also stated that many of these classes are associated with high wage, high demand employment such as welding, emergency medical response and medical terminology. In the p-tech program alone there are 9 students graduating with a high school diploma and an Associate's degree in process technology. A number of these students intend to go on to 4-year colleges to pursue engineering

degrees, a few more are hoping to go straight from school to work while at least one student intends to join the military and pursue process technology job opportunities. Besides dual-enrollment courses, Ms. Vallelungo announced that participation in on campus class certifications are also growing. These certifications allow students to leave school with resume' highlights that help gain employment.

After all questions and comments from the Committee were addressed, Mrs. Dysart thanked Ms. Vallelungo for her presentation.

Mr. Granberry addressed Personnel changes for the month of April. All questions and comments from Committee members were addressed by Mr. Granberry. Congratulations were offered to Mr. Roy Cucullu, Ms. Allie Alphonso and Ms. Marlene Petrie who were listed as retirees on the Personnel changes.

Mr. Fernandez presented to the Finance Committee for their review the 2015-2016 Revised General Fund, Special Revenue Fund and Lunch Fund Budgets. Questions and comments from Committee members which followed were addressed by Mr. Fernandez.

Mr. Long made a motion to recommend to the board to approve the revisions made to the 2015-2016 General Fund, Special Revenue Fund and Lunch Fund Budgets. Seconded by Mr. Warner, the motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote of the members present.

Under Superintendent's Recommendations Ms. Voitier stated that the Celebrating Our School Community Banquet will take place on Wednesday, April 20, 2016 where students, teachers, staff and parents will be honored. She also noted that on April 27th there is a St. Bernard Day at the Capitol and invited Board Members to attend. Finally, she mentioned that on Saturday, April 30th is the Job Fair for open teaching positions for the 2016-2017 School Year.

There being no further business, on motion of Mr. Campbell, seconded by Mrs. Nicosia and passed by a unanimous vote of the members present, the Committee adjourned.
