February

Counselors will send out emails inviting students to sign up for a course selection meeting Students/Parents review recommendations in Genesis (After 1/31 12PM)

Meetings are between student and counselor only

March

If eligible, a student can appeal <u>two</u> classes (due 3/6)
Student will be notified by content supervisor (decision emailed by 3/26)
Parent can override an appeal denial for <u>one</u> class
Overrides must be completed by 3PM on April 4
