As a University of Tennessee Flagship School, Austin-East Magnet High School graduates enrolling as first-time, first-year students at UT are eligible to receive the Flagship Scholarship. Combined with the HOPE Scholarship, it covers tuition and mandatory fees for up to eight semesters, equivalent to nearly \$52,000 over four years.

AEMHS serves grades 9-12, operates on a four-block schedule, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. every day, except Wednesday when classes start at 8:50 a.m., and on the four half days when school ends at 12 p.m.

ACADEMICS

Austin-East Magnet High School gives students the opportunity to earn college credit by offering a number of Advanced Placement (AP), Statewide Dual Credit (SDC), Dual Enrollment (DE) classes and Industry Certifications.

AP classes are high school courses that follow a rigorous college-level curriculum for which students can earn high school credit; they may also earn college credits with a qualifying score on an optional final exam.

SDC classes are college-level courses taught at the high school level by trained high-school teachers. Students who meet or exceed the course exam requirements receive college credit that can be applied to any Tennessee public postsecondary institution.

DE classes are college courses for which a high school student is enrolled simultaneously at a postsecondary institution. Successful completion of the course results in both high school and college credits.
