


Owassa Public Schools 2025 SCHOOL BOND OVERVIEW



WHY A SCHOOL BOND NOW?

One of the initiatives identified in the district's 5-year strategic plan is the implementation of Full-Day Pre-K across the district by 2028. To create space at all elementary schools, we will build a 5th Grade Center next to the 6th Grade Center, located on 129th Street.

Additionally, each capital project included in this bond was identified as a need by district leaders during the Long Range Facility Planning process. Between Strategic Planning and Long Range Facility Planning, the elements of this resolution have been carefully thought-out over the last two years with the help of feedback from district parents, teachers, and community members.

WHAT IS THE TOTAL COST OF THIS BOND?

The 2025 school bond includes two propositions that total \$197.5 million over seven years. Per Oklahoma law, transportation items must be listed as a separate proposition from other projects.

EXPANDING THE MILLAGE RATE

The current target millage rate for Owasso Public Schools is 28.75. For this school bond, we are asking the community to expand that target to 31. What does that mean for your pocketbook?
