ATHLETICS

FHS serves grades 9-12, operates on a four-block schedule, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. every day, except Wednesday when classes start at 8:50 a.m., and on the four half days when school ends at 12 p.m.

ACADEMICS

FHS gives students the opportunity to earn college credit by offering Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Enrollment (DE) classes.

AP classes are high school courses that follow a rigorous college-level curriculum for which students can earn high school credit; they may also earn college credits with a qualifying score on an optional final exam.

DE classes are college courses for which a high school student is enrolled simultaneously at a postsecondary institution. Successful completion of the course results in both high school and college credits.
