Application Fee	NEW Families: This nonrefundable fee is paid at the time of initial application. CURRENT Families: The New Sibling Application Fee will be credited to the family account if the admissions application is submitted no later than 12/16/24 and the new sibling's enrollment is finalized.	\$150/First Student \$50/Each Sibling due with application	
	This nonrefundable fee is paid yearly and is due at the time of enrollment/re-enrollment. This fee		
	pays for yearly account administrative functions and also holds the student's class placement.		
Enrollment Fee	NEW Families: New Student Application must be submitted by February 1 to receive PRIORITY enrollment fee discount of \$250 (for new families enrolling a first child in grades K-12). Applications received after February 1 and on or before May 1, will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount. CURRENT Families: ALL re-enrollment steps must be complete by February 28 to receive a \$250 PRIORITY discount off of the enrollment fee. Re-enrollment completed after February 28 and on or before May 1 will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.	\$550/Family \$250 PRIORITY discount by priority deadline \$100 discount by May 1 due upon enrollment/ re-enrollment

Enhancement Fee	By volunteering in the school community beginning June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026, this yearly fee is reimbursed to the family's account at the rate of \$15 per volunteer hour.	\$150/Family due upon enrollment/ re-enrollment	
Student Fee	This yearly fee covers the cost of most classroom supplies, student yearbook, emergency preparedness materials, required standardized testing expenses, campus security as well as lower school costs associated with curriculum and book rental. This fee is also used to cover expenses for classroom supplements and co-curricular programs.	\$400/student due by June 1 or upon enrollment/ re-enrollment	
Spanish Immersion Deposit	This yearly deposit applies to students enrolling/reenrolling in the Spanish Immersion Program in $1^{\text{st}} - 5^{\text{th}}$ grades. This yearly deposit accumulates on the family's account for each year the student remains in Spanish Immersion (through 5^{th} grade). The total amount paid will be applied as a credit to the family's account upon successful reenrollment into 6^{th} grade thereby reducing the family's tuition obligation. This deposit is non-refundable should the student withdraw from RCS or switch to the English program after the 1st semester of 1st grade or at any time in grades 2nd - 5th.	\$250/student due by June 1 or upon enrollment/ re-enrollment	
	The yearly discounted Extended Care Plans are available for purchase beginning 5/1/25 through

Miscellaneous Fees/Costs

Additional costs include split financial accounts, special instructional supplies and expenses relating to field trips, class trips, class pictures, SOAR and special events. There is an additional cost for students who require an aide as part of their Special Education services; that cost is dependent upon the percentage of time an aide is required.
