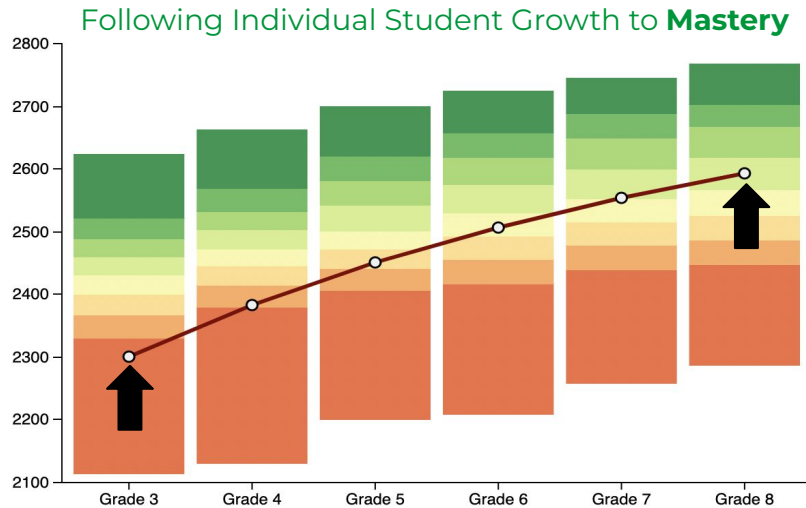

# SBA Growth Success Metrics

1. **Growth Rate (GR)** is the percent of students meeting their **individual growth targets**.
2. **Average Percentage of Target Achieved (APTA)** is the percent of aggregate target growth points.



**Think about it this way:**

*A 3rd grade student performing at **Level 1** should achieve at **Level 3** by 8th grade if they meet **100% of their growth targets.***

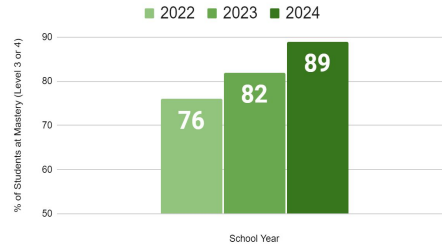


### Mathematicians in Grades 3 and 4

% of Students Making Average or Above Average Growth: BOY to EOY 2023-24

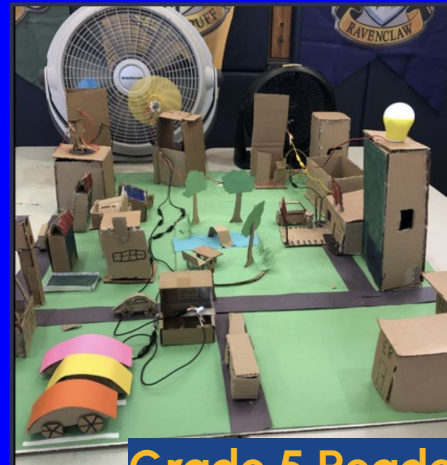

ELA and Math Cohort Achievement - Class of 2024

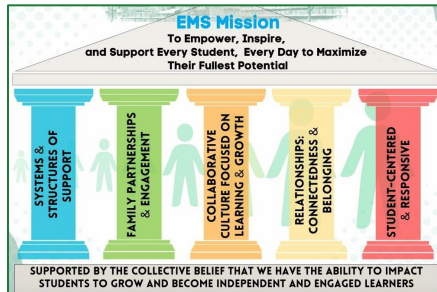
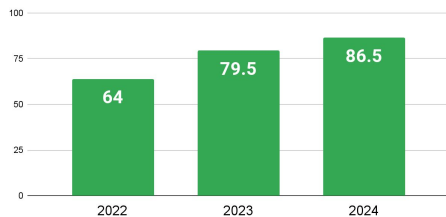


ELA and Math Cohort Growth Rate - Class of 2024

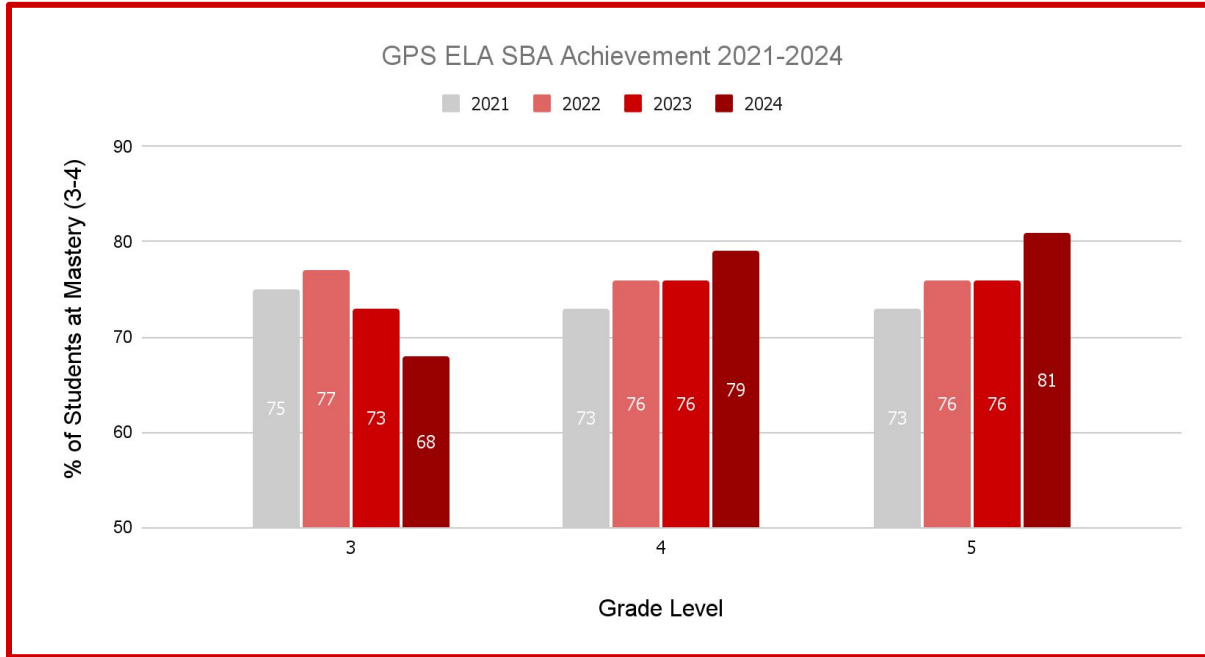

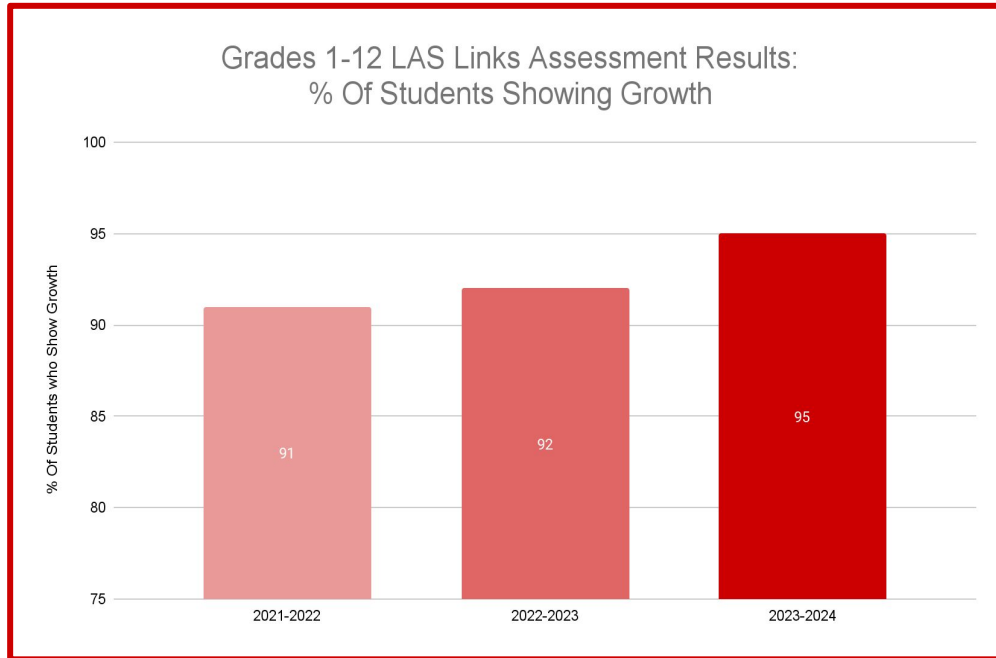
## SAT: Grades 9-12 Students with High Needs
