



WHAT IS TITLE I?

- Federal program under Elementary & Secondary Education Act
- Provides financial assistance to schools with high percentages of students from low-income households
- Purpose: to ensure all children have equal opportunity to get a high-quality education.

FEATURES

➤ **Funding:** schools receive federal funds to provide additional support for academics

➤ **Qualifications:** schools qualify for funding if a large percentage of student households are low-income.

➤ **Funds For:**

- Academic support
- Professional Development for teachers
- Parental involvement
- Educational resources

WHY IT MATTERS

➤ **Equity in Education:** Helps bridge the gap between schools with more resources and those with fewer resources.

➤ **Support for Struggling Students:** Provides assistance who need it most, helping them succeed in school.

➤ **Improving Schools:** It supports school-wide initiatives aimed at increasing student achievement and closing gaps.

THE IMPACT

➤ **Academic Achievement:** Schools with Title I funds often see improvements in student performance

➤ **School Improvement:** Schools are able to implement strategies that improve teaching and learning environments

➤ **Parental Involvement:** We are able to emphasize the role of parents in education and foster greater collaboration and involvement between families and schools
