


ENROLLMENT FOR 2025/26 BEGINS JANUARY 14


KYRENE KICKBALL - KYRENE INTRAMURALS!!!!


KTA Book Fair: February 3 - 7

The Kyrene School Board approved a 60-day review of middle school 6-8 grade English language arts (ELA) curriculum resources. As part of the public review process, the curriculum materials and digital resources from the selected vendors will be available at our middle school campuses and the Kyrene District Office throughout the review process.

The on-site curriculum materials review will be available from November 20, 2024 - February 24, 2025.

Parents and community members may visit a Kyrene middle school to review materials in person. Please bring a photo ID and sign in at the front office to review on-site materials.
