

Game Instructions

1. Prepare the game by printing one recording form per students. Each pair of students will need a deck of cards with aces and face cards removed. For each pair of students, one will be designated as player 1 and the other as player 2.
2. Each partner chooses 2 cards off of the top of the deck. They then arrange their cards to make a 2-digit number.
3. Partners record their two digit numbers on their recording form and write a comparison statement using $<$, $>$ or $=$ to compare the two numbers.
4. The partner with the greater number earns a point. The player with the most points at the conclusion of the game is the winner.

If any of your students are having difficulty in playing this game, you may benefit from using hands on materials such as linking cubes, base ten blocks or a representative model such as a place value drawing or a place value chart.
