Based on current projections, Pittsford Schools will remain flat **with the potential of a slight increase** from 2024 to 2034.

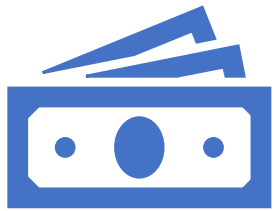
Projections by individual schools must be continually monitored.

Our enrollment projections have been 91% accurate over the past ten years

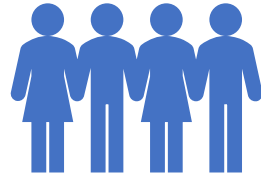

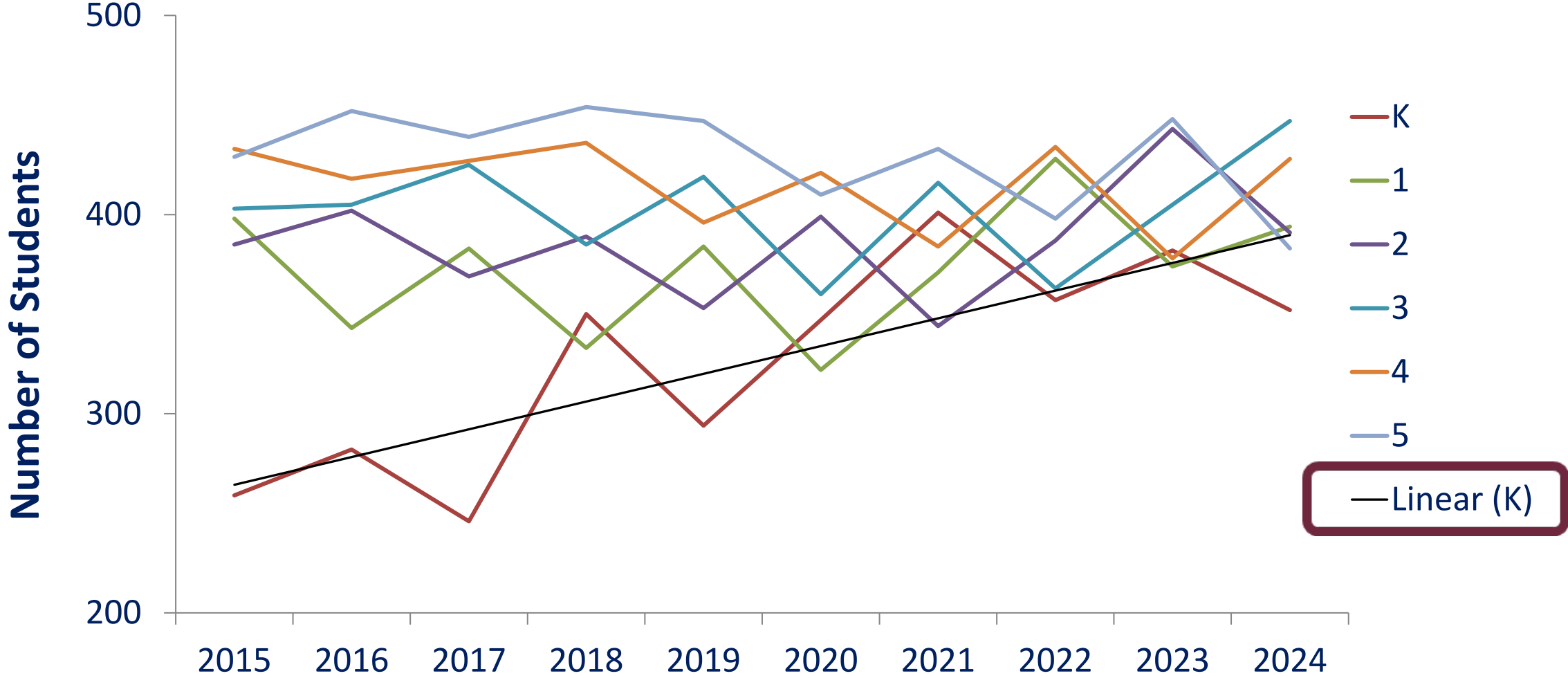

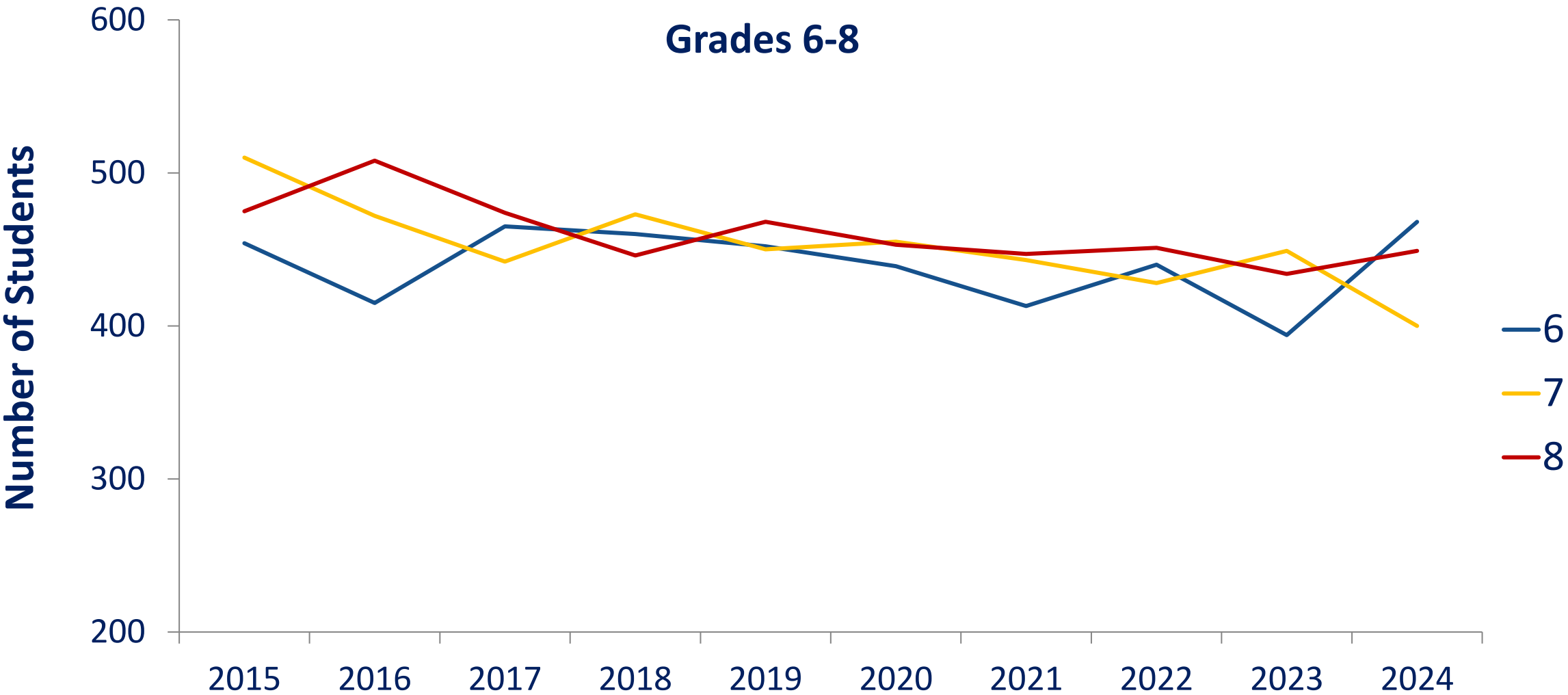

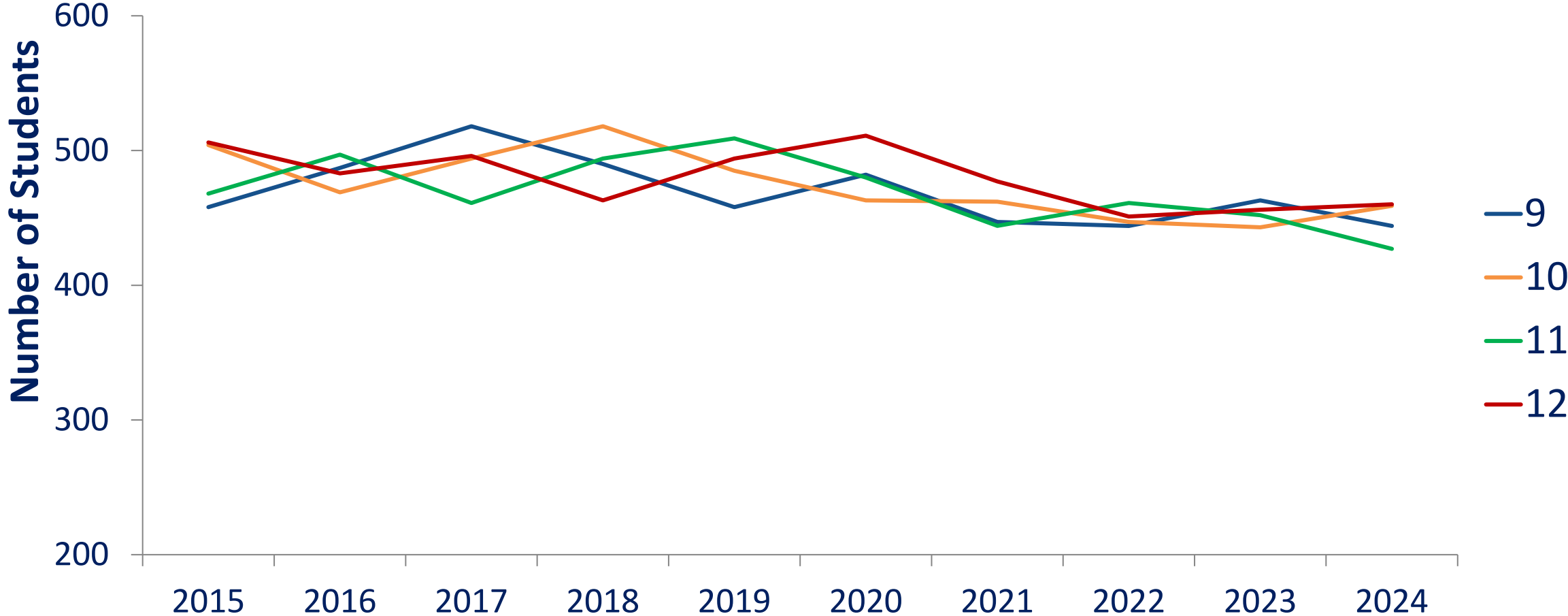

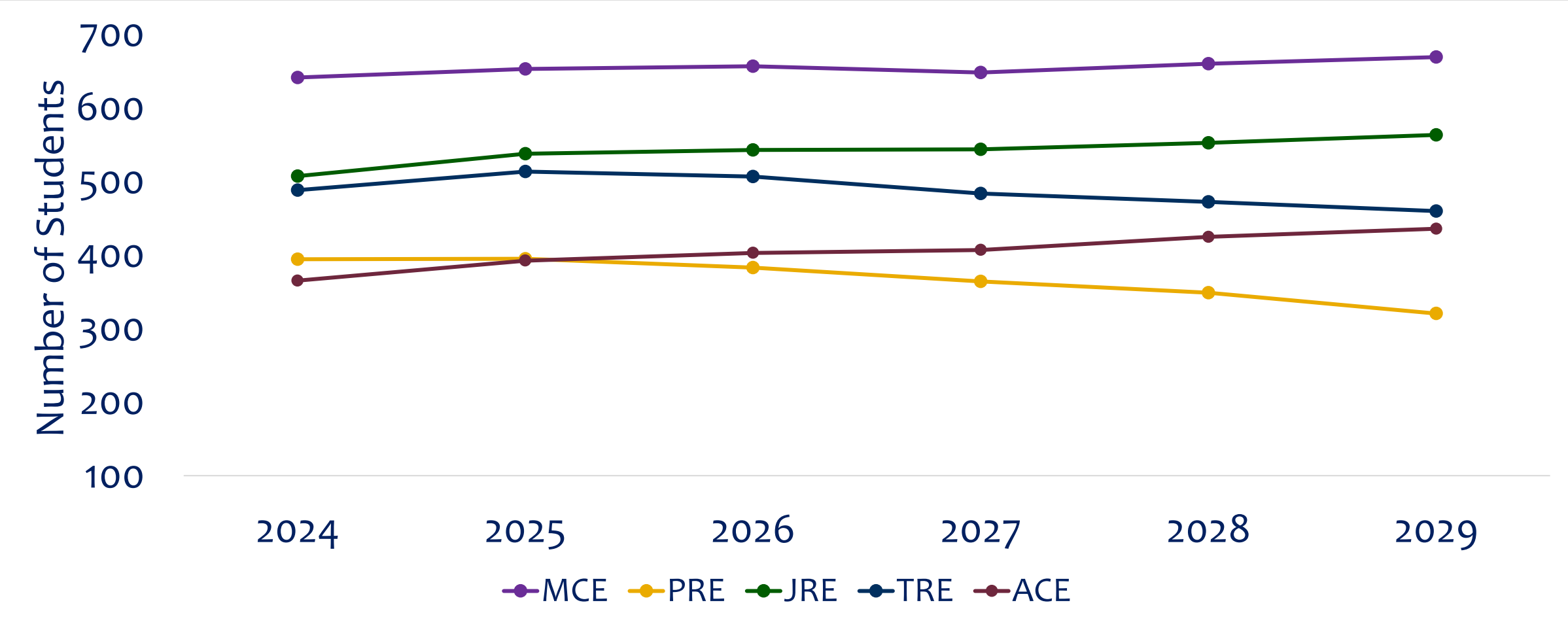

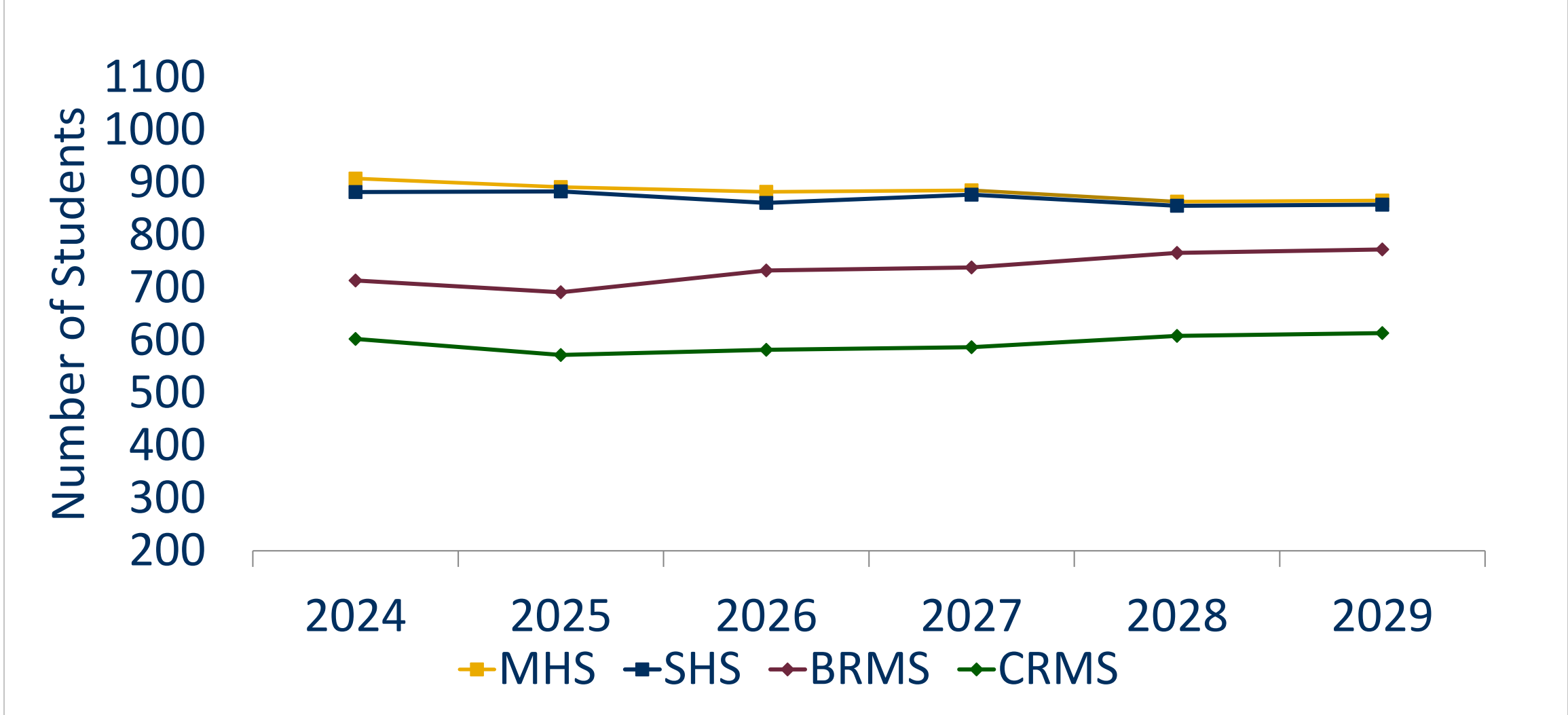

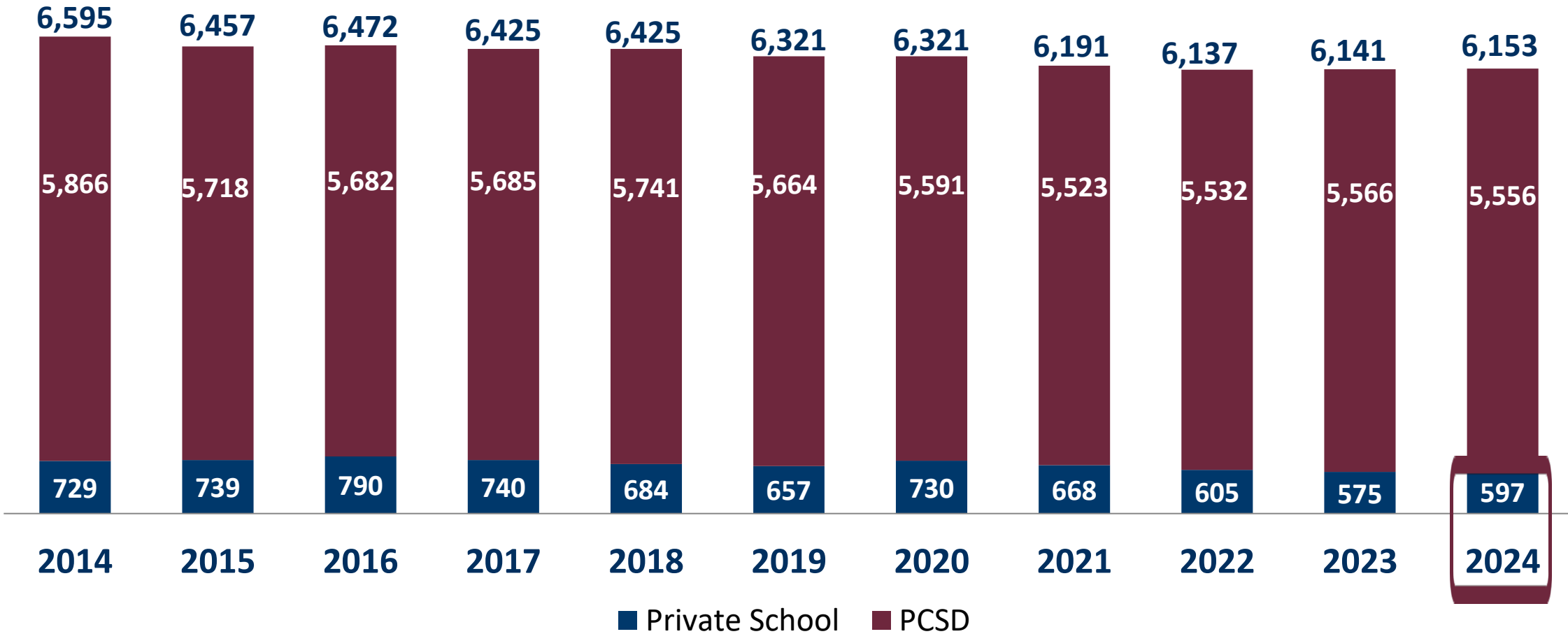

Public School Population Decrease 2014 to 2024 = 5.3% (Average decrease over 10 years is .53% per year)  
Private School Population Decrease 2014 to 2024 = 18.1% (Average decrease over 10 years is 1.8% per year)

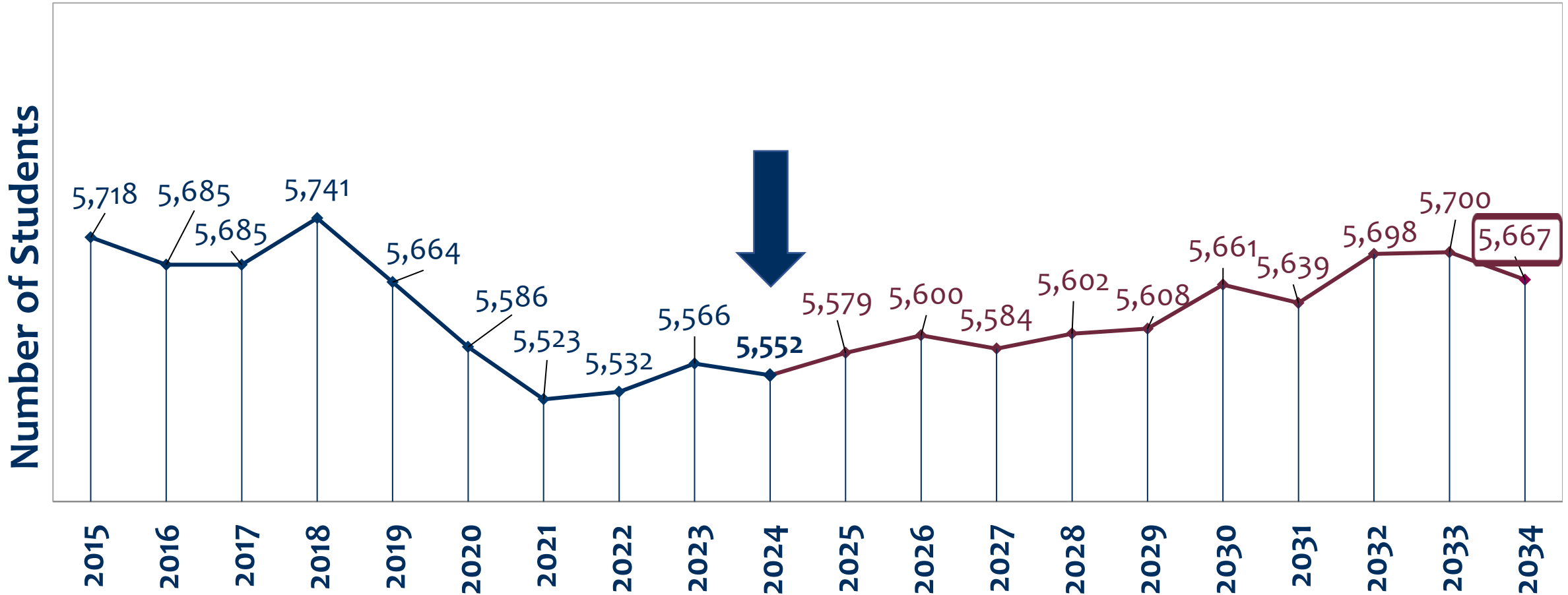

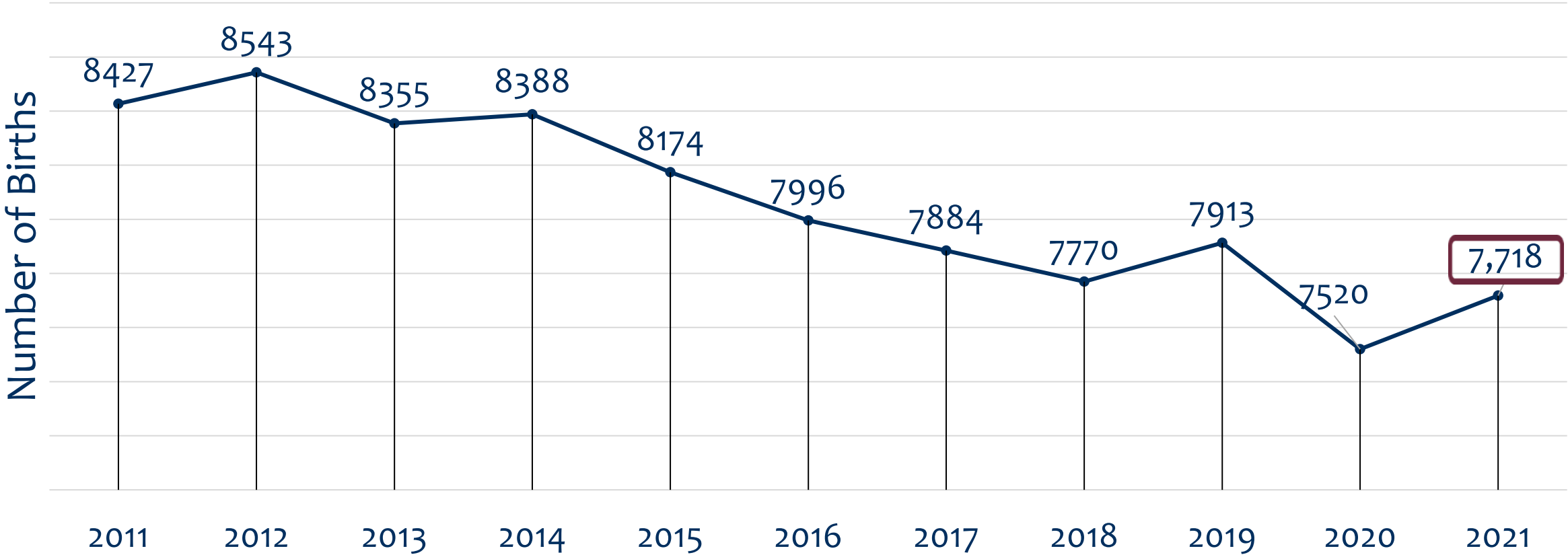

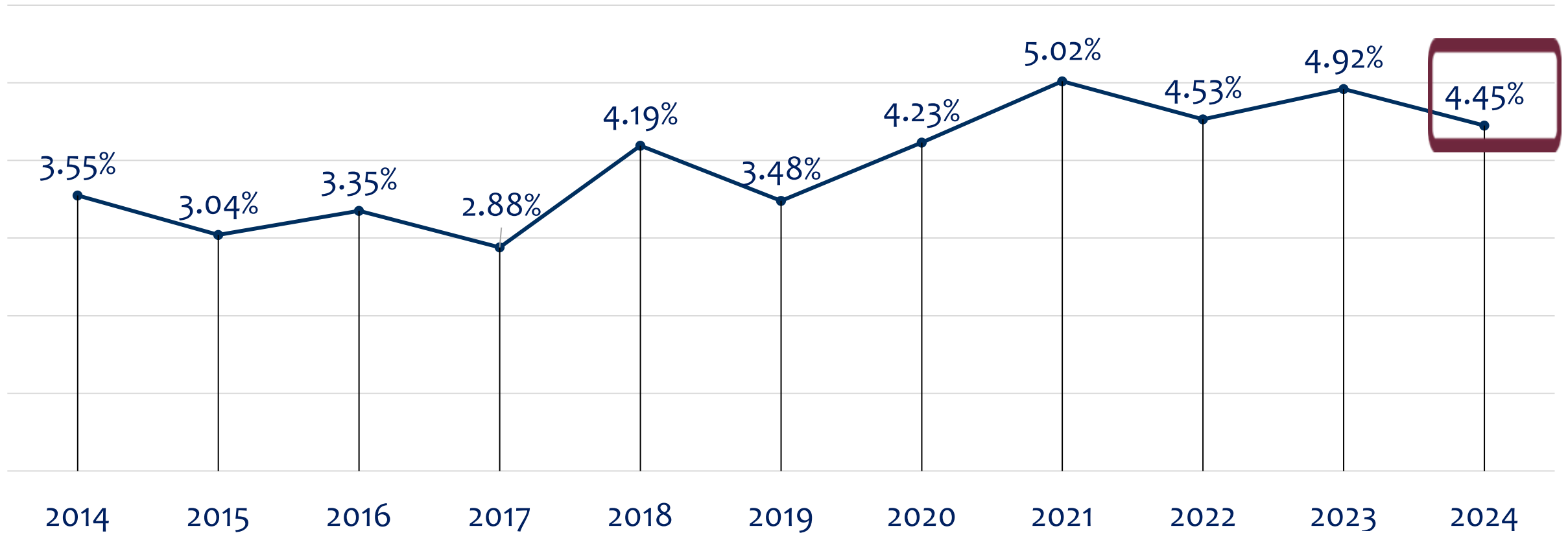

2014-2024 PCSD Grade K Percentage out of Total Monroe County Births

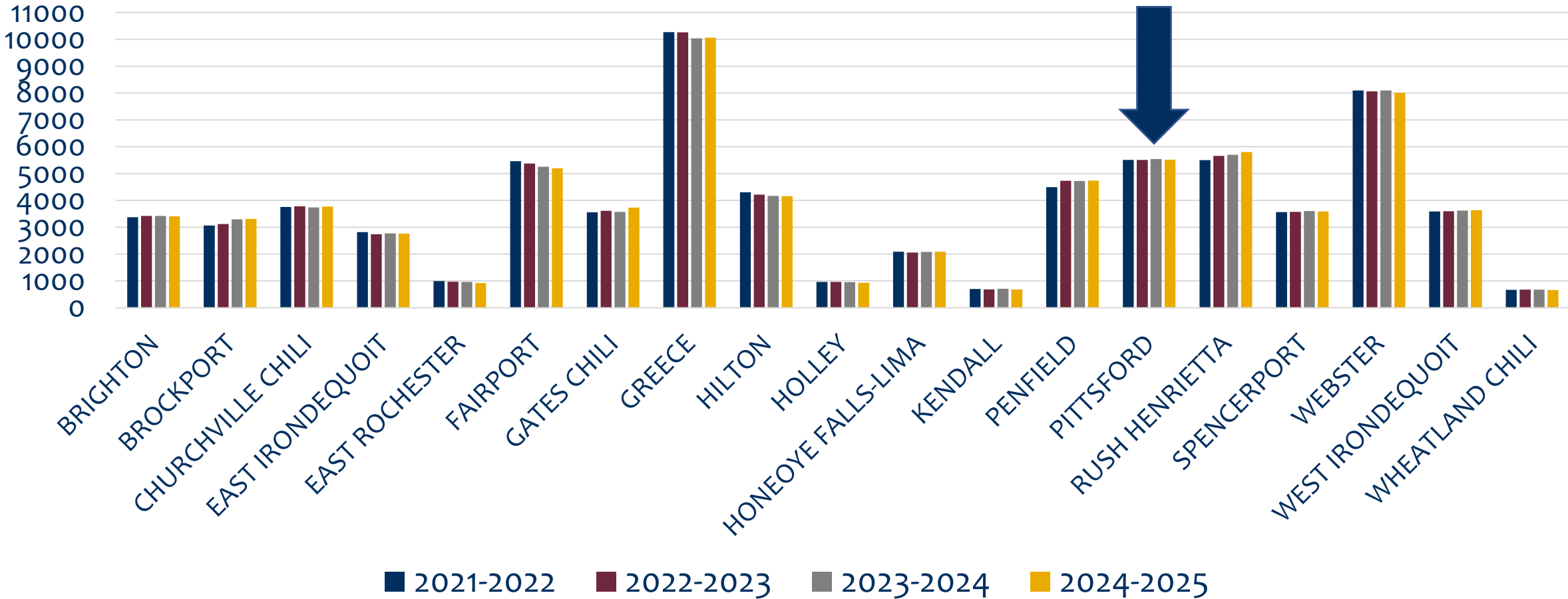

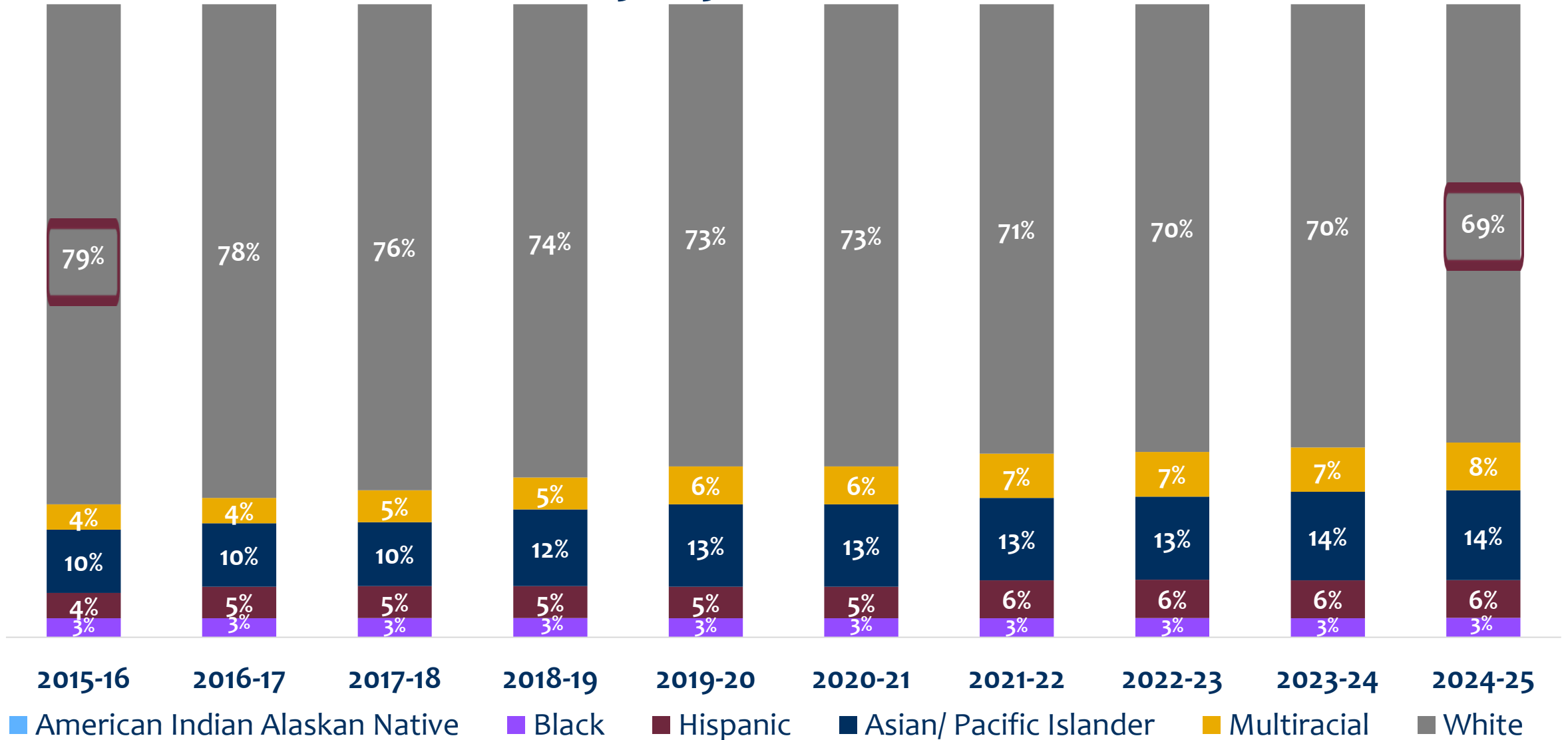

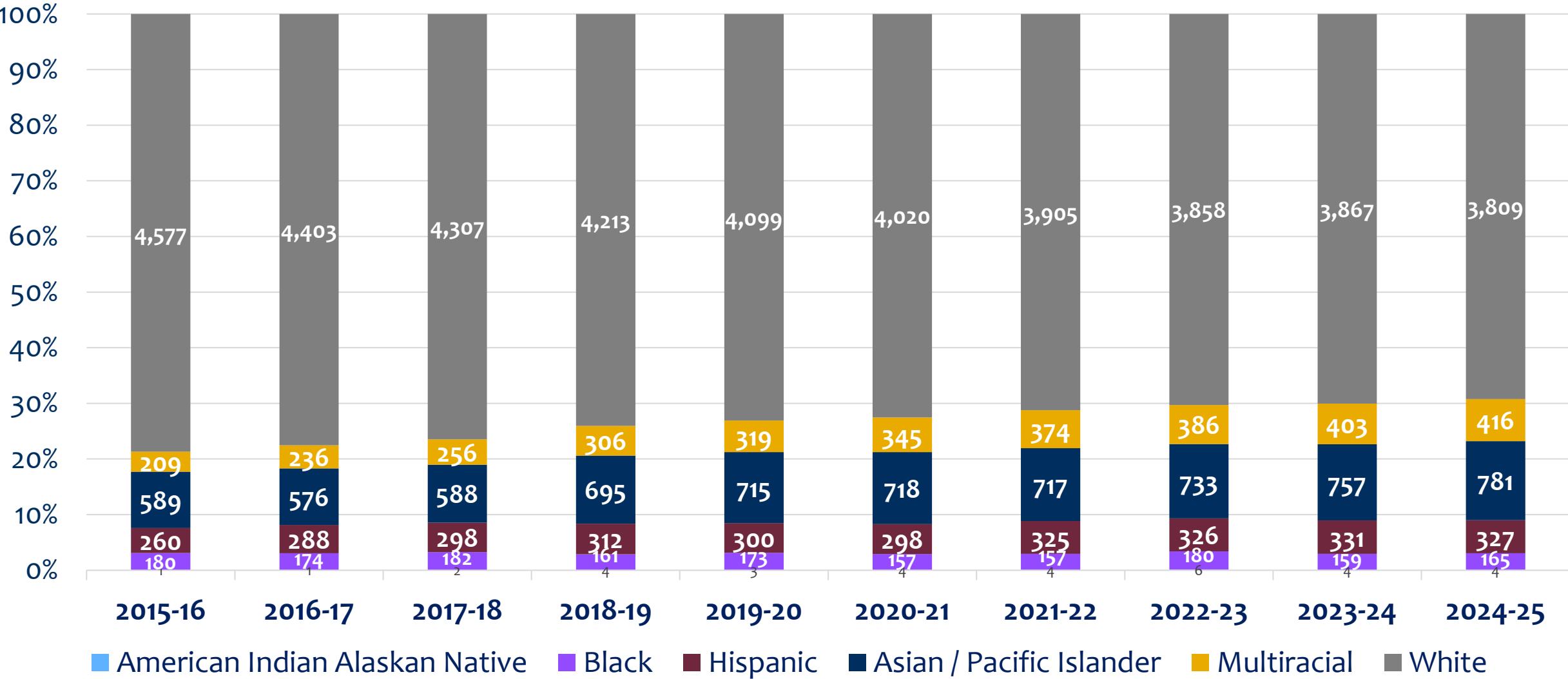


# PCSD Race and Ethnicity by Percent of Total

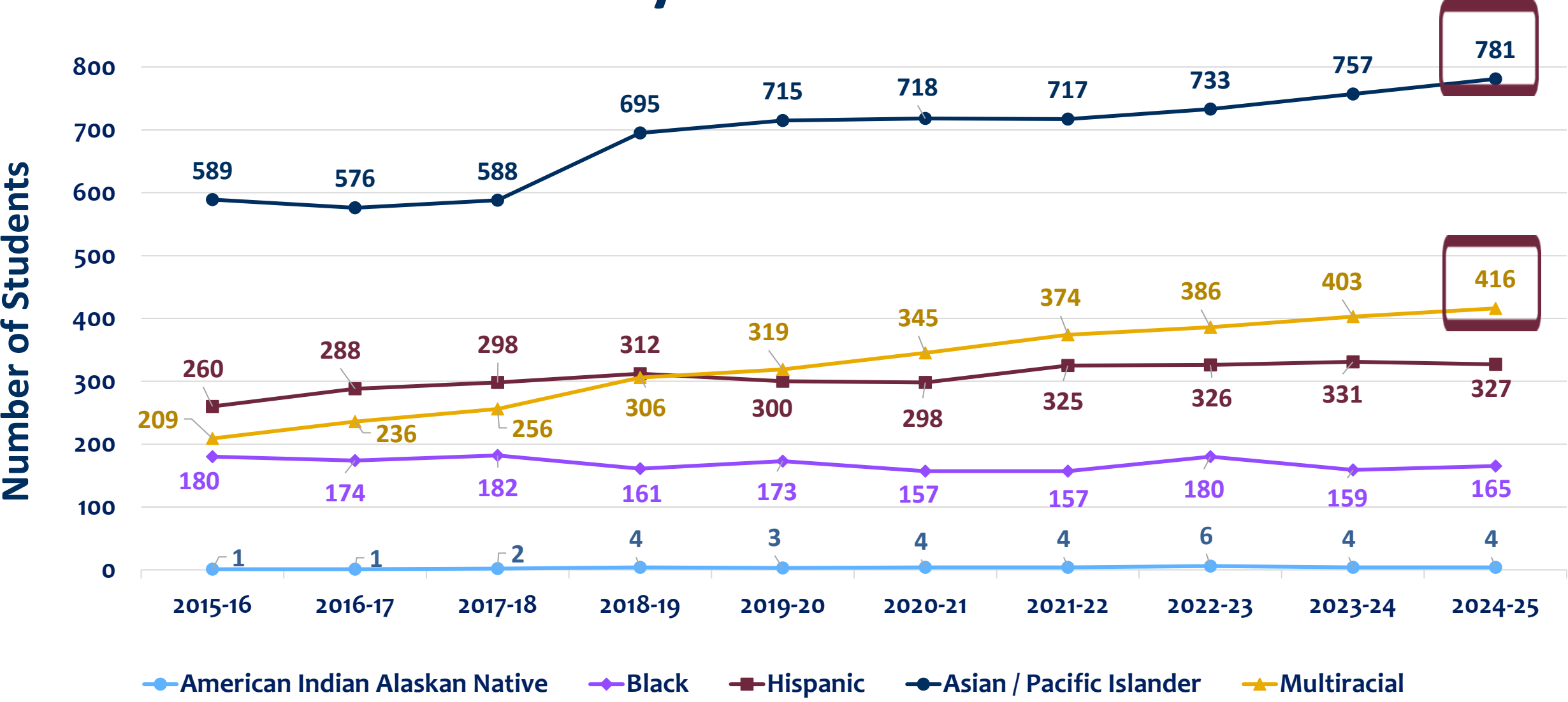
# PCSD Race and Ethnicity over 10 Years

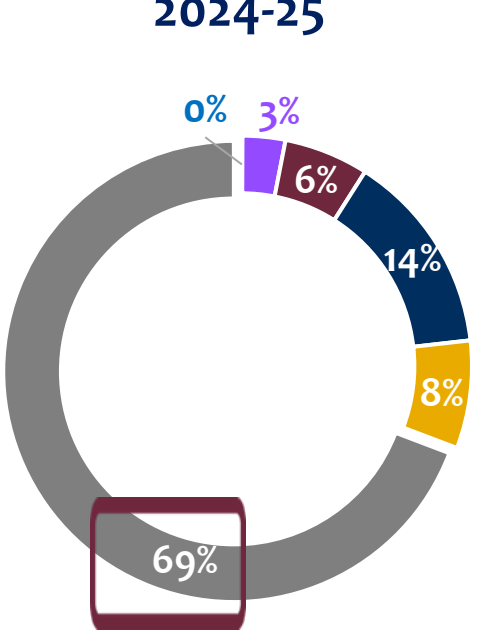
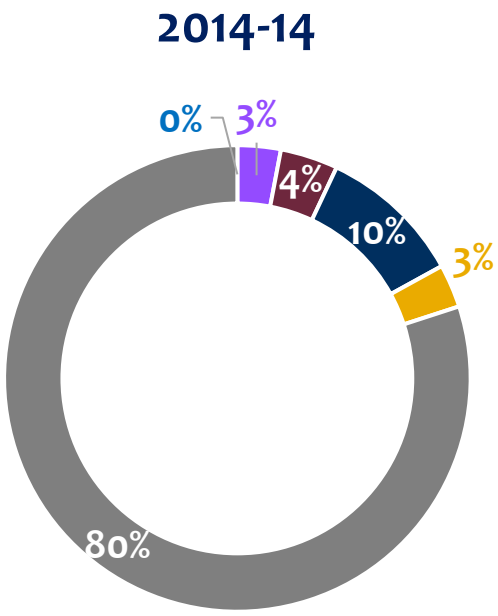
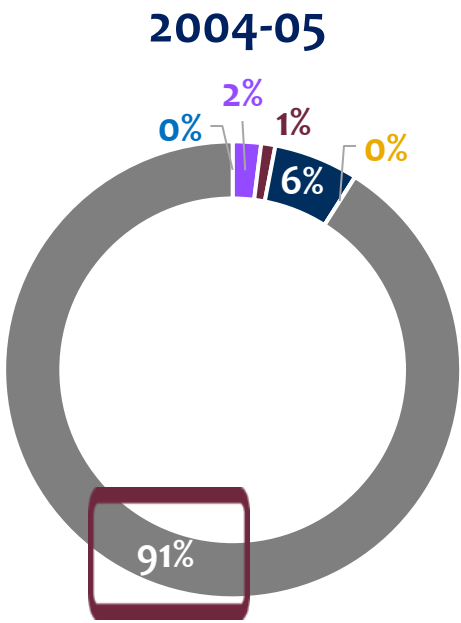
# PCSD Race and Ethnicity Over Ten Years

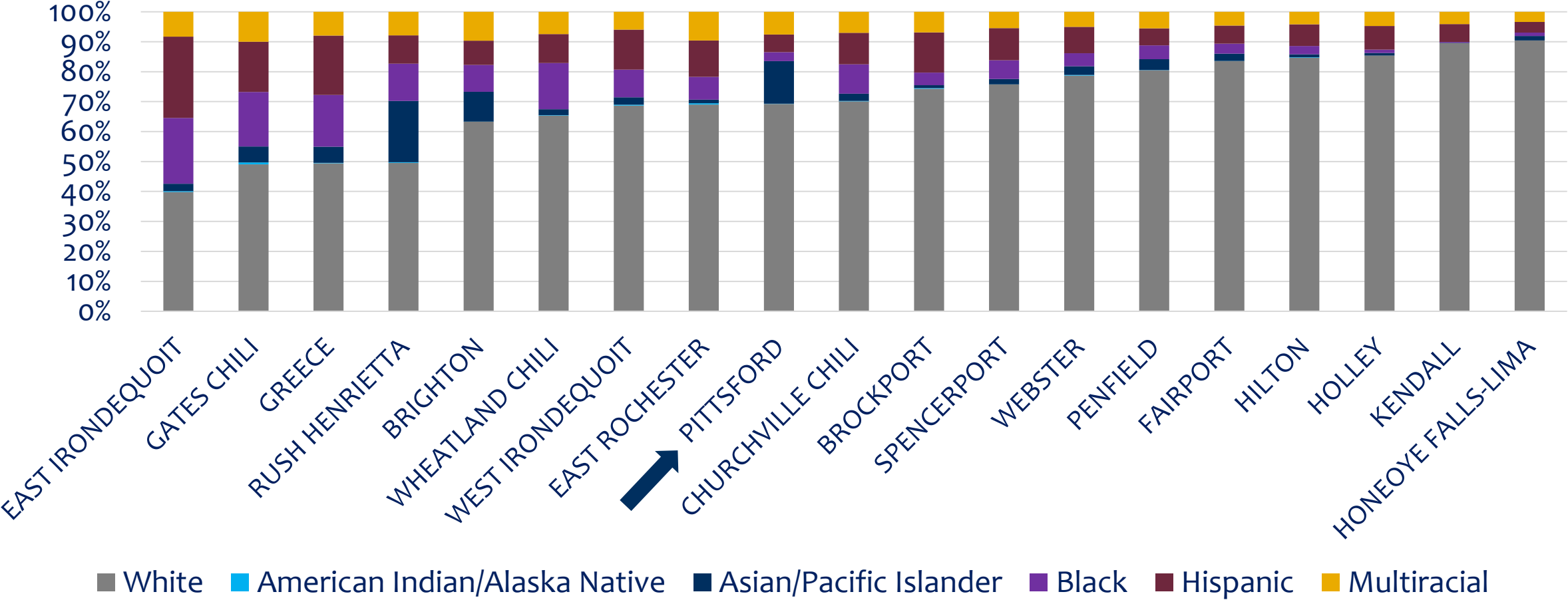

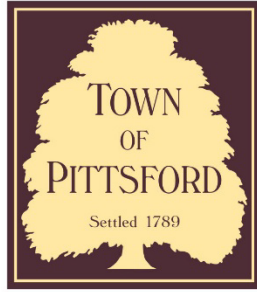

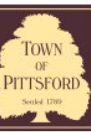

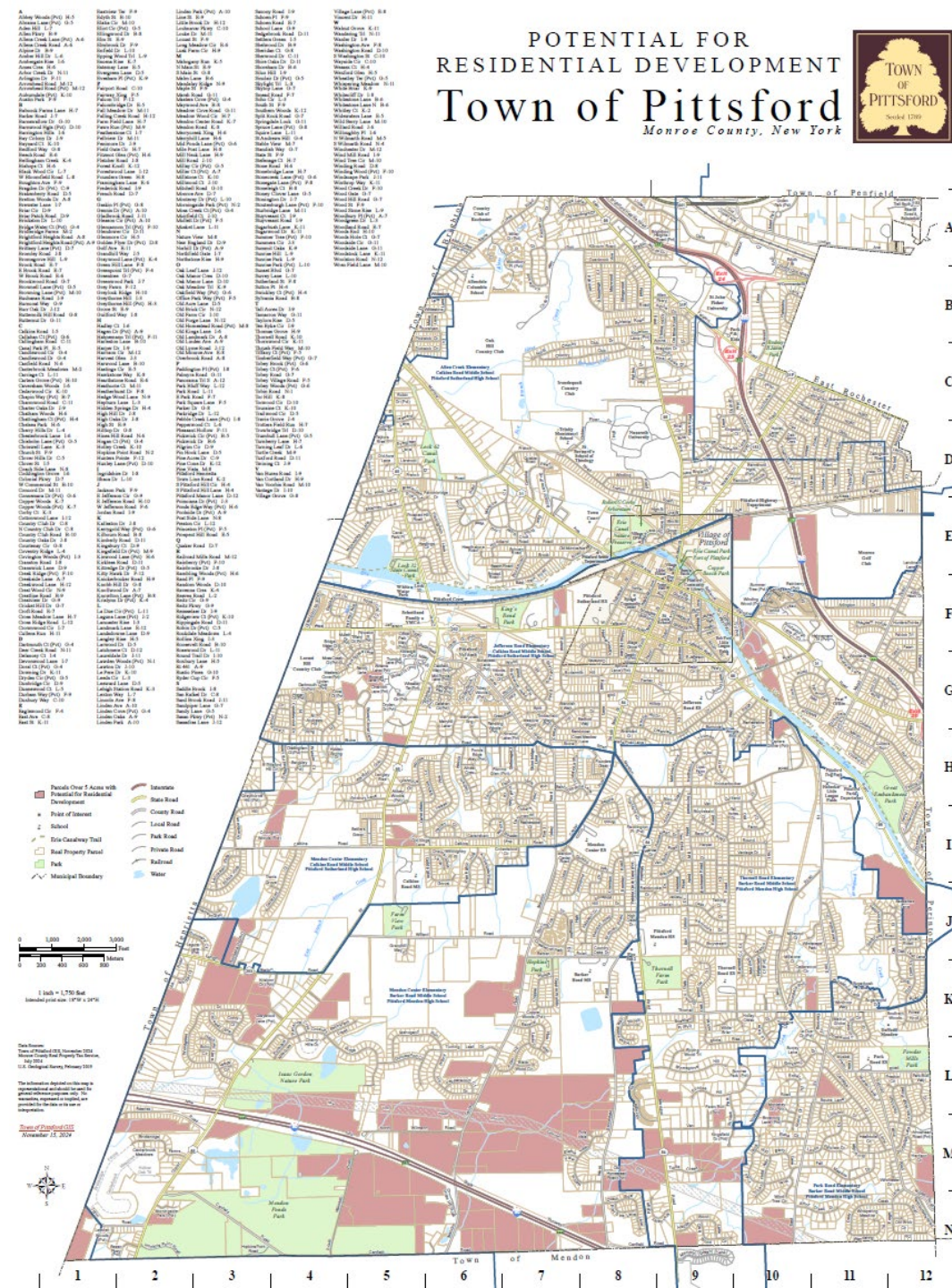

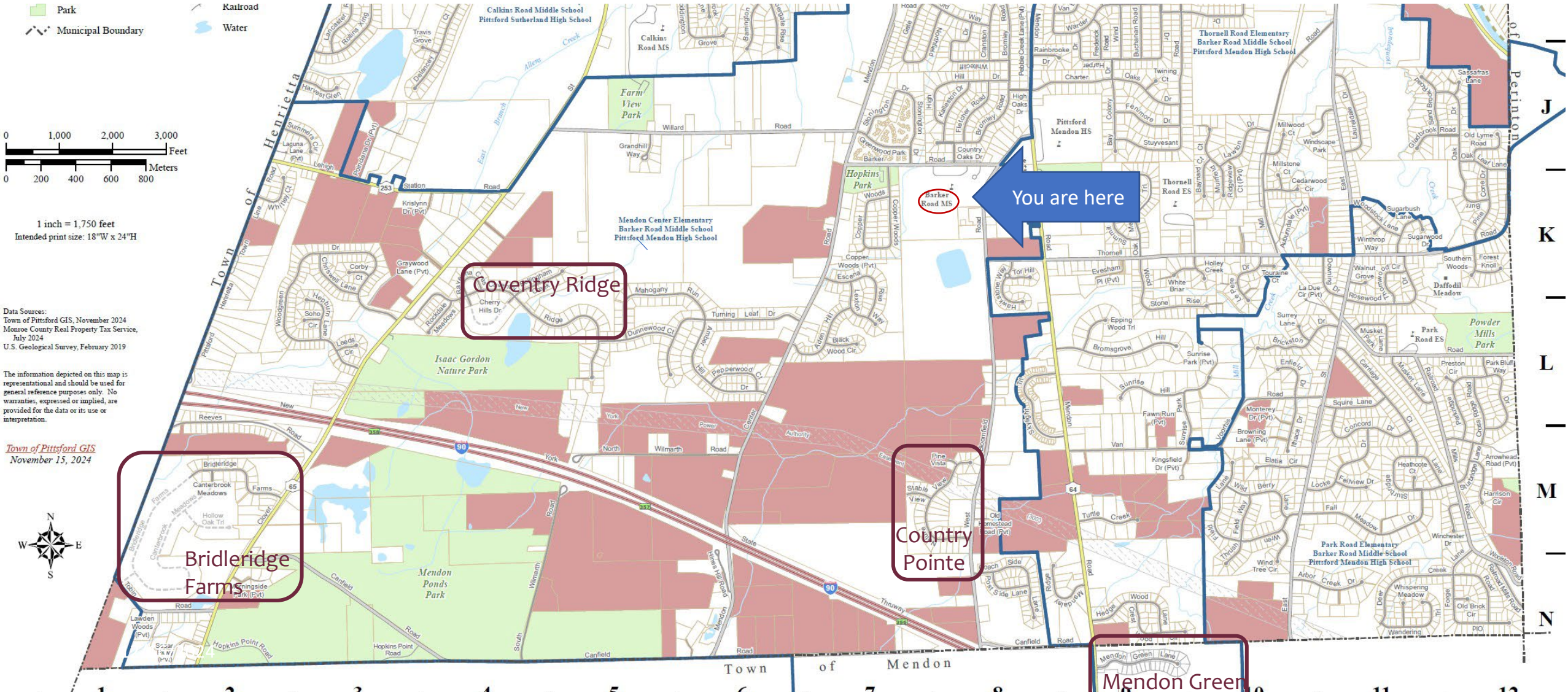

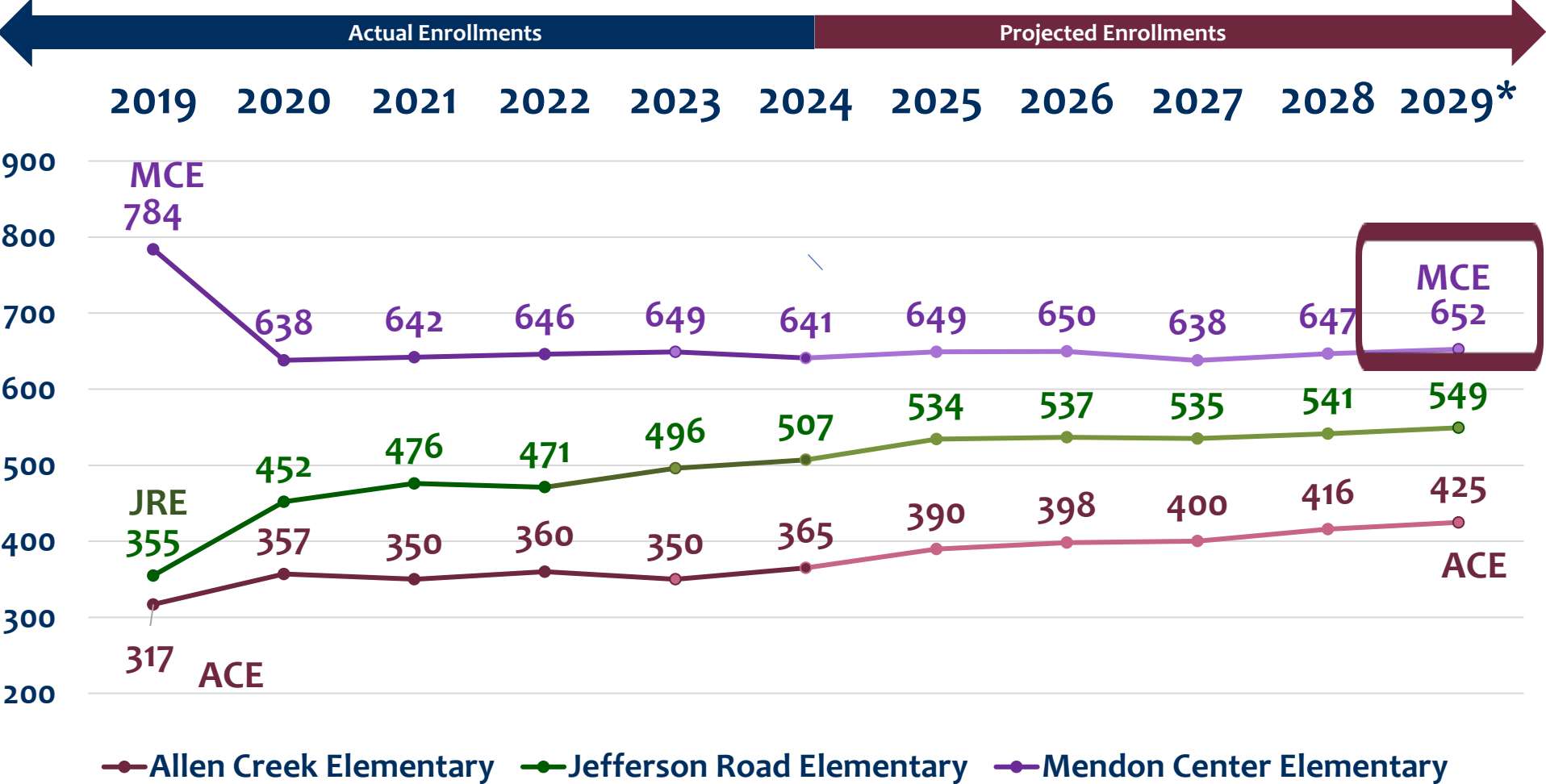

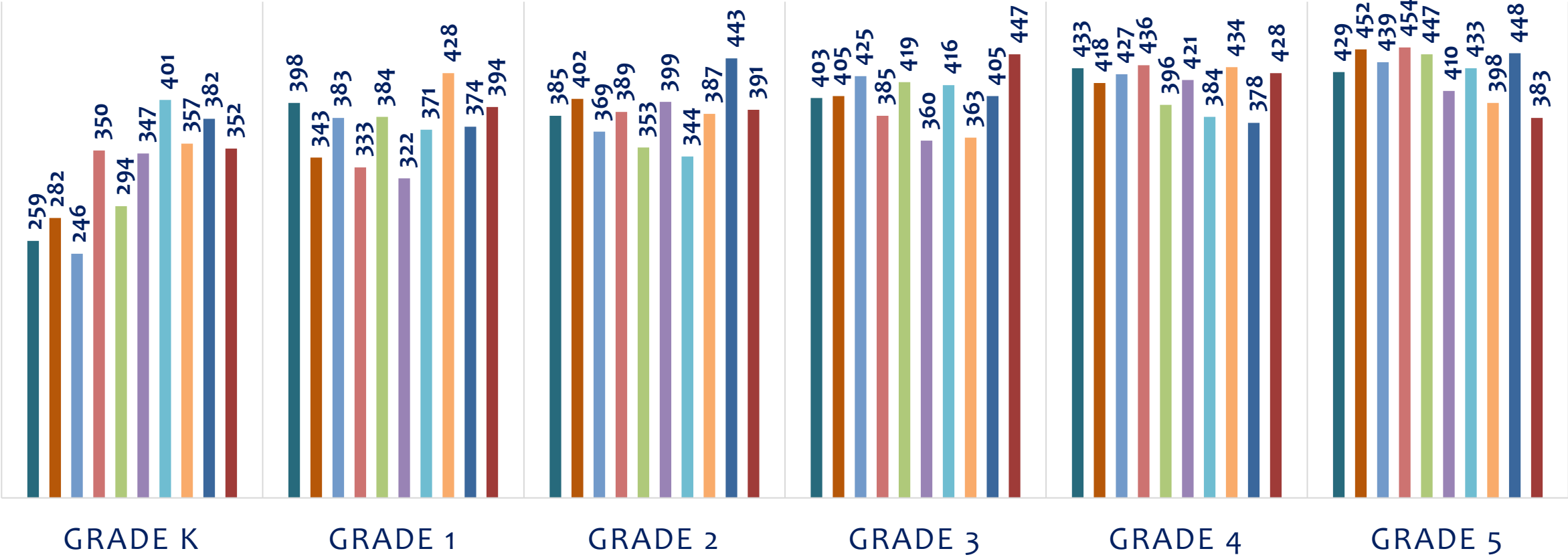

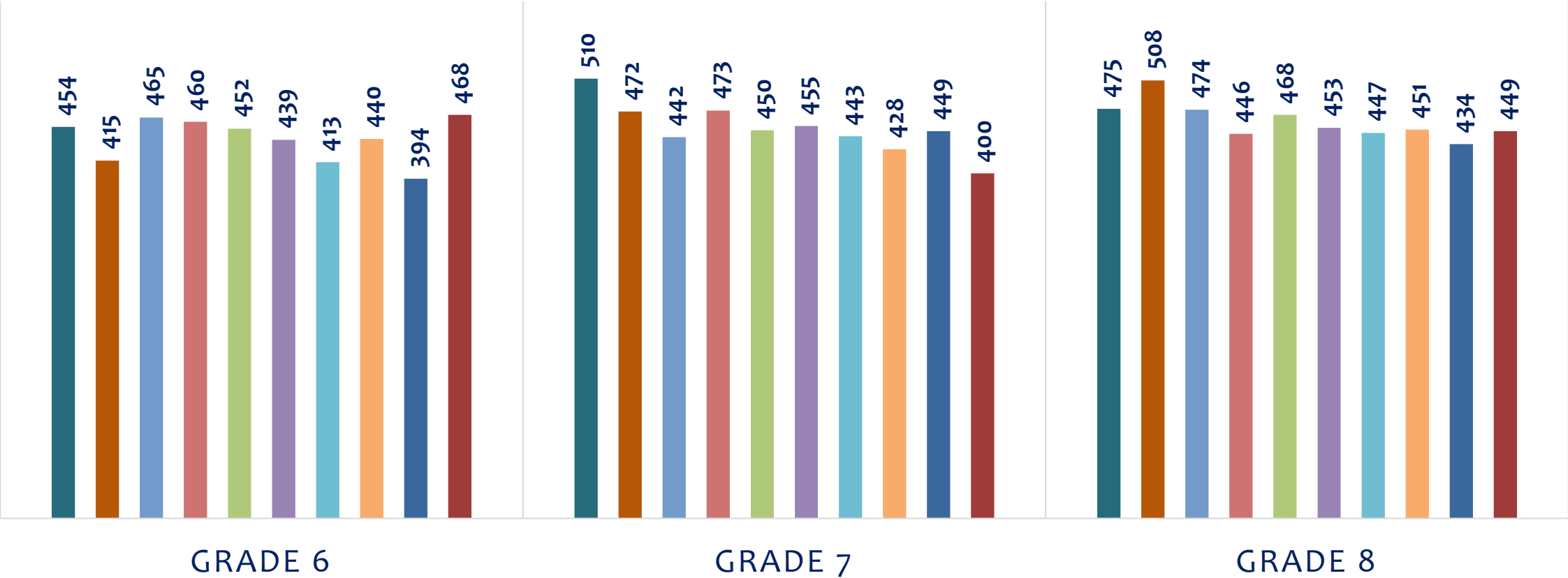

## GRADE 6-8 ENROLLMENT TREND

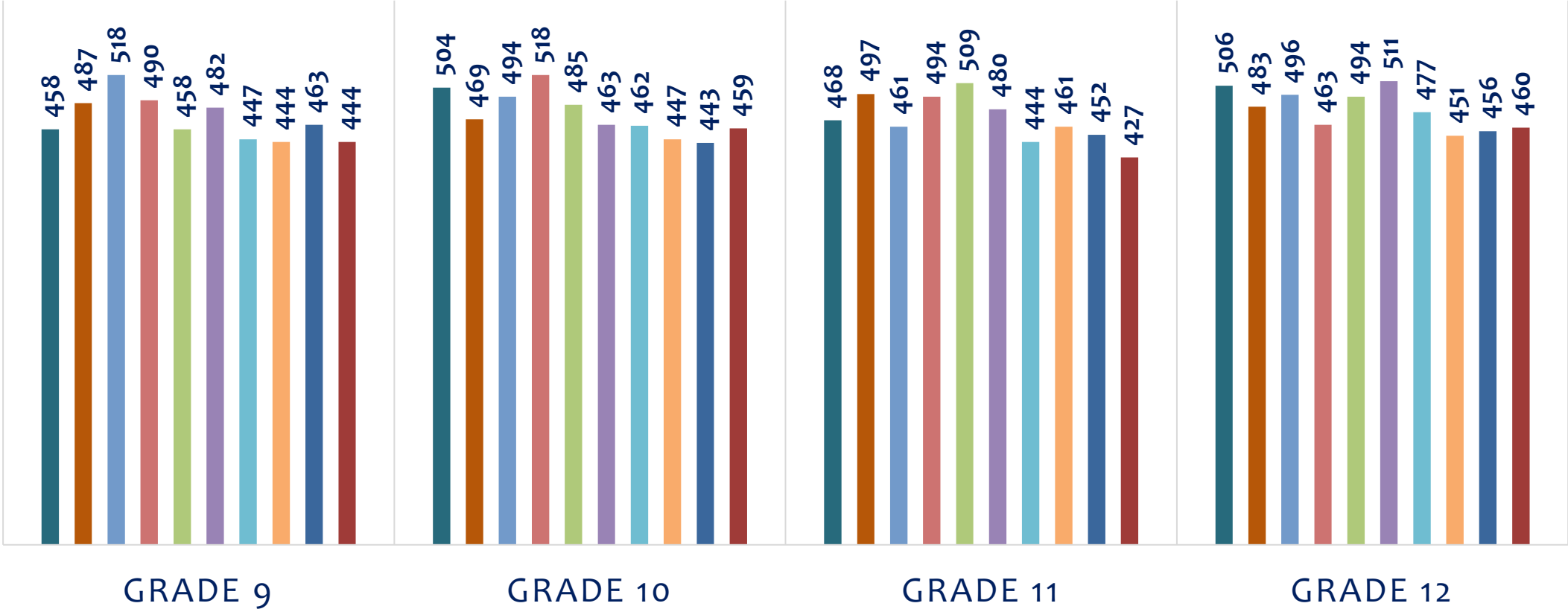
