3. Prior to **February 3rd** you must select your classes on-line:
 - a) Log into your PowerSchool account. <https://ps1.chelsea.k12.mi.us/public/home.html>
 - b) In the left hand column, click on **CLASS REGISTRATION**
 - c) Make your selections and **hit “submit”**
(Warning: If you hit submit and have not inputted the information correctly, you will receive an “error” message and need to start over. Double check your work before hitting submit!)
4. Be prepared to discuss your senior course selections along with your college and career plans at your individual appointment with your counselor.

The “master schedule” will be developed based on your selections, therefore, please put careful thought into your selections. It may be difficult to switch classes at a later date.
