 We hereby determine, in accordance with G.L. c. 70B, that the cost of the (i) New District
 High School project authorized by a vote of the Committee passed on February 10, 2014,
 (ii) Varnum Brook School Feasibility Study project authorized by a vote of the Committee
 passed on September 12, 2016, (iii) Hawthorne Brook School Feasibility Study project
 authorized by a vote of the Committee passed on September 12, 2016, (iv) Varnum Brook
 Elementary School Renovations project authorized by a vote of the Committee passed on
 September 12, 2016, (v) Hawthorne Brook Middle School Renovations project authorized
 by vote of the District passed on April 3, 2017, and (vi) Squannacook Early Childhood
 Center Renovations project authorized by a vote of the Committee passed on on April 3,
 2017, each being financed with proceeds of a portion of the Notes defined below, together
 with all other bonds and notes of the District previously issued to pay costs of these
 projects, does not exceed the portion of the total cost of the projects that are not being
 paid by the school facilities grants and we hereby approve the issuance of notes and bonds
 to finance these projects under G.L. c. 70B.

<u>Further Voted</u>: to approve the sale of \$17,910,984 4.00 percent General Obligation Bond Anticipation Notes (the "Notes") of the District dated January 30, 2025, and payable October 30, 2025, to Truist Securities, Inc. at par and accrued interest, if any plus a premium of \$146,332.74.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that in connection with the marketing and sale of the Notes, the preparation and distribution of a Notice of Sale and Preliminary Official Statement dated December 30, 2024, and a final Official Statement dated January 8, 2025, each in such form as may be approved by the District Treasurer, be and hereby are ratified, confirmed, approved and adopted.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that the District Treasurer and the Chair of the Committee be, and hereby are, authorized to execute and deliver a significant events disclosure undertaking in compliance with SEC Rule 15c2-12 in such form as may be approved by bond counsel to the District, which undertaking shall be incorporated by reference in the Notes for the benefit of the holders of the Notes from time to time.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that we authorize and direct the District Treasurer to establish post issuance federal tax compliance procedures and continuing disclosure procedures in such forms as the District Treasurer and bond counsel deem sufficient, or if such procedures are currently in place, to review and update said procedures, in order to monitor and maintain the tax-exempt status of the Notes and to comply with relevant securities laws.

<u>Further Voted</u>: that any certificates or documents relating to the Notes (collectively, the "Documents"), may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be regarded

	as an original and all of which shall constitute one and the same document; delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to a Document by electronic mail in a ".pdf" file or by other electronic transmission shall be as effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart signature page to such Document; and electronic signatures on any of the Documents shall be deemed original signatures for the purposes of the Documents and all matters relating thereto, having the same legal effect as original signatures.	
	<u>Further Voted</u> : that each member of the Committee, the District Secretary and the District Treasurer be and hereby are, authorized to take any and all such actions, and execute and deliver such certificates, receipts or other documents as may be determined by them, or any of them, to be necessary or convenient to carry into effect the provisions of the foregoing votes.
