Dear Parent/Guardian:

At Cherokee Elementary we are very proud of our teachers and feel they are ready to provide your child with a high-quality education. As a Title I school, we must meet federal rules related to teacher qualifications as defined in Every Student Succeeds Act. These rules allow you to learn more about your child's teachers' training and credentials. We are happy to provide this information to you. At any time you may ask:

- Whether the teacher met state qualifications and certification requirements for the grade level and subjects that he/she is teaching
- Whether the teacher received an emergency or conditional certificate through which state qualifications were waived
- What undergraduate or graduate degrees the teacher holds, including graduate certificates, additional degrees, and major areas of concentration.

Mrs. Kaylee Hassell, Mrs. Lacey Figueroa, Ms. Allison Shackleford, Ms. Dayna Watts, and Mrs. Chloe Brunson currently have a bachelors' degree in other areas. They knew teaching was their passion and are currently taking the required courses to gain their education degree.
