



# **Bundle Up**







- **Students:** Dress appropriately for the cold weather to stay warm and safe.
- Wear layers: Layers trap heat and allow for adjustments as needed.
- Hats and gloves: Keep your head and hands warm.
- **Boots:** Insulated, water-resistant boots to keep feet warm and dry.
- Scarves or neck warmers: Help protect the face and neck from cold winds.
- Water-resistant jacket: A jacket that can repel rain or snow will help ensure students stay dry and comfortable.

**Tip**: Remember, it's easier to remove layers if you get too warm, but it's harder to add warmth once you're cold..

# **Arrive Early**

- Plan to leave with extra time to safely reach the bus stop.
- Watch for unplowed driveways, untreated sidewalks, and icy roads.
- Wear proper footwear and stay cautious.

### Be aware that:

- Some roads and sidewalks may still need clearing.
- Not all neighbors may have had a chance to plow or salt driveways.

## **Be Observant**

- Watch for traffic, icy spots, and hazards on the way to the bus stop.
- Limit distractions: avoid headphones and phones while walking.
- Step back while waiting for the bus to stop safely.
- Prevent accidents by staying away from roads and vehicles.

### Be Patient

- Ice/Snow on roads slow down travel times.
- Expect delays and walk slowly when entering or exiting the bus.
- Use the handrail for safety.



# **Winter Driving Tips for Drivers**

- Slow down and be cautious around school buses.
- Always watch for flashing bus lights and keep a safe distance.
- Wait at least 3 seconds before entering intersections.
- Be mindful of icy bridges, overpasses, and school zones.

To stay updated on bus pickup and dropoff times, especially during weather disruptions, you can check the Manor ISD Transportation dashboard directly. Manor ISD provides real-time updates or adjustments in cases of delays due to weather conditions related to freezing temperatures.
