
6. How many additional PK-1 classrooms do you think are needed?







If you think there's a need for playground equipment improvement, describe the need.

- ADA compliant equipment with rubber service or turf on ground
- Improvement of playground equipment as well as the playground base. Especially for the west playground.
- update old playground
- Replace damaged equipment
- Our front playground near the office has areas that are a safety hazard.
- The gravel is an issue with students and there is rust on the equipment which is a safety concerns. In addition, the students would benefit from a fence around the area.
- We need equipment that can host a larger number of students. The old playground needs the rocks taken out and the rusty equipment updated. There needs to be a fence around the old playground as well. A walking track around the interior of the fence would also be good.
- We just added a playground to the east. A fence around the west playground would be nice. Changing the pea gravel to a different surface would also be benficial.
- I would like to see the "old red" playground to be updated to have more options for our students.
- More equipment for younger children. Some of our equipment is too large for ages 5 to 7. I would also think it beneficial for a fence or barrier around entire play area.
- If we expand, I feel a separate building on WV property would be best and include an infant/toddler building. A separate building would allow us to only worry about our standards and not have additional school standards on top of the accreditation standards of our building.
- We need more playground space with swings and slides.
- There never seems to be enough swings
- Basketball courts that aren't in driveway. Enough equipment for amount of students that use at same time .
- We just need to equipment for the students to play on. Having over 80 students at one time for recess makes taking turns tough. Would also love for it to be closed in, to help keep students safe.
- Replace the playground on the south side of the building. The main play structure is rusted and in need of repairs/replacement.
- N/a. We just got the new playground
- For the playground by first grade hallway, take away rocks
- Please take out rocks
- Pls get rid of rocks and sliding pole
- We need 2 playgrounds that can be used. Replace rocks and update equipment
- Only the west one, update and add items, make safer
- Replace the small rocks on the old playground with cushion floor like the new playground.
- Newer playground where the old one is
- I would defer to the teachers on this question.

- Remove the rocks from the front playground and replace with something more durable and safe for the students. This front playground is very essential to our students at Westview.
- Remove rocks from door 13 playground. Add more swings to door 10 playground.
- Replace playground on the south end of the building. Current play structure has rusted.
- Completely replacing the old playground would be ideal. The more our enrollment goes up the more play space we need. The rocks need to be removed and replaced with a padding similar to the new playground.
- Replace playground jungle gym out front (rusted and has sharp edges), get rid of gravel (very dangerous, children have had to go to the hospital due to injuries)
- Westview's old playground needs to be updated, removing the rocks and instead putting flat ground for the students to run on instead.
- Updates to the older playground area by gym.
- We just updated our playgrounds. I think that is a lower priority.
- More swings
- More swings, no gravel, no possible place for sitting water or mud
- we need to refurbish or add additional playground equipment to what we already have. If we add more classrooms, we're going to need more play space
- I think the playgrounds are ok for now
- The older playground needs replaced and fenced in.
- The rock playground, that is out by the basketball courts, needs a fence for safety, multiple students have ran. The basketball hoops need to be lowered so K/1 students can actually shoot at the hoops.
- More handicap accessable equipment. More equipment in both playgrounds again if expanding to include more students.
- Better equipments for smaller kids.
- The red playground could be upgraded
- Remove small rocks
- More swings in the newest playground
- more swings, something under the mulch where the swings are currently
- Remove rocks on one of the playgrounds.
- Get rid of the rocks from the front playground facility and replace with a sponge blacktop
- Remove the rocks. Fence in an area so they can play in the grass. Take out the ball game, dinosaur, and big silver slide.

- I think a new preschool wing or building should be top priority which includes a storage facility alongside that hallway or building
- When adding to the building please try to make it squared for easy security either playground in the middle.
- A storage facility or more storage space added to the existing building.
- We need more office spaces and possibly more K-1 classrooms as well to accommodate special classes (science, lego, art/music/library/gym), resource and intervention. Right now these spaces are in closets made by partitions in our library, actual closets or storage / stage areas and on a cart.
- I think that covers it.
- "I would love to have a fence around the old playground.
- The new playground is great, but I would love to see more equipment to host the large number of students that go to recess at one time.
- As long as we are dreaming, along with the cafeteria and gym, a multipurpose room would be great! It can host grade level rotations, indoor recess, Santa Shop, Book Fairs, etc and not disturb lunch cycles and specials classes."
- More storage. I'm not up to date on the maintenance needs of the building.
- Our student restrooms that are shared in the classrooms have not been updated since 2000. These restrooms were for K-5 and are too high of toilets for our students. We also would benefit from each classroom having their own restroom or more stalls.
- Outdoor awning for pick up and drop off that expands the sidewalk. Our staff if out in rain and snow daily to help our young students. PreK building on WV site but separate from K and 1st grade.
- More Preschool and on-site staff daycare
- A lab school in connection with the Infant/Toddler and preschool program would allow a bridge between the College Prep program at the High School, Ivy Tech and our youngest learners.
- Replace the older tile floors in classrooms
- Digital sign out front
- Digital sign with landscaping.
- "In addition to gen ed classroom, there is a need for classroom for our specials.
- It would also be great to have a couple additional offices, having those spaces available for testing/meetings/counseling would be super beneficial! "
- Classroom flooring (carpet and tile) needs replaced. Classroom walls and trim needs painted.
- Each specials should have their own classroom and adding 2 more classrooms per grade level.
- Each Specials class should have their own classrooms. We also need more classrooms together so all grade level teams are together.

- Move classroom tv's the front of the room (above whiteboard).
- I feel like this survey covered all of the major areas of need.
- New flooring in the classrooms. (Easier to clean since we are now eating breakfast in our rooms.)
- As the Lego STEM Teacher, I would really appreciate a more functional classroom space beyond the space on the stage.
- Classroom carpets and tile need replaced. Classroom walls and trim needs painted.
- New paint and flooring in all classrooms.
- Top priority is that classrooms need renovated. Carpet needs replaced with tile floor like in Mrs. Baiao's classroom (all dark grey). Sink/water fountains in classroom need fixed or replaced. Classroom's need painted. Other than construction, westview's classroom furniture is EXTREMELY outdated and there is simply not enough for classroom to be functional.
- Some sinks continue to run water after they have been turned off
- There is a need for rooms for our Occupational Therpaists, Speech Therapists, and Parent-Teacher Conference Rooms.
- Expansion of space for support staff such as counseling, specials classrooms, meeting space, etc.
- Mainly adding space for more students.
- Restrooms for preschool, more storage in classrooms.
- New flooring in classrooms (no more carpet please). Assessing the sinks in classrooms. New/better/more recent furniture for teachers and students. I believe that the Paras and those in charge of them should have their own space. Desks, a room for them to have meetings and do what they need to do, room for them to keep their stuff.
- Traffic flow improvement and parking spaces
- New exterior doors and windows so much air and dust comes through them, bathrooms need redone floors are missing tile and they need
 revamped badly
- My strongest opinion is more classrooms!
- Bigger teacher work lounge to fit all teachers needs. A new laminator. Staff parking signs.
- Adding more special education classrooms. A bigger space for the k-1 resource classroom.
- Whether an early child care learning center is separate, attached to WV, or classrooms are added, the WV kitchen needs to be expanded and renovated. There is absolutely no room for additional CN employees to work, more equipment nor storage at WV to keep up with the demand. If we have more students to feed, we need to be sure we have what we need to feed them.
- Additional rooms for special education an additional speech therapy room, a room for a school psychologist, and an actual conference room
- I feel like a new preschool building or wing should be the top priority with added storage space
- Move ty's from the corner of the classroom to the front of the rooms above the whiteboard.
- There is need for more room for specials, intervention, and a bigger staff lounge.
- would be nice for each classroom to have their own restroom (not shared), for special teachers have their own classrooms
