

This includes viewing the number of tests they've completed, how many they still need to take, and whether they missed a testing day for specific classes while on campus. Staying informed helps ensure your student stays on track for success and spells any rumors you may receive from your students that our teachers "do not let them take tests." Testing days are assigned this year to keep everyone on track!

Looking at this semester, we will also be sending home paper progress reports on a regular basis.
