


English & Math Placement

ELASS Changes for 25-26

Effective in the upcoming 25-26 academic year, the new format will have ELASS scheduled as independent, subject-specific classes with one teacher in each 55-minute class period.

This change in format shifts the class from being a blended, integrated curriculum to a cross-disciplinary focus. Students will be instructed with the goal of making cross-curricular connections between the English and Social Studies content by viewing one discipline from the perspective of the other. Both courses will emphasize analyzing evidence from the historical record using a variety of lenses and perspectives and synthesizing that knowledge through the study of literary texts that will challenge students to make meaningful connections between the two content areas.

Reading and writing activities in both subject areas will emphasize the skills of text analysis and synthesis through the organization and composition of constructed responses, DBQs, as well as explanatory and argumentative essays. The independent courses will continue to focus on the needs of our highly performing students and student performance proficiencies will continue to be reviewed annually to ensure proper placement and opportunity for growth.




