PROGRESS ON SIC GOAL FOR 2024-2025

Our School Improvement Council meets once a month. Our SIC works collaboratively to accomplish 3 yearly goals. This year our goals were increasing parent engagement, implementing a 5th-grade mentoring program titled "Guys with Ties and Girls with Pearls", and improving our school's climate and culture.

Our SIC increased parent engagement by sponsoring grade-level parent orientations this year.
