

GENERAL ELECTIVES

CHOOSING YOUR CLASSES

- Today we are going to focus on enrolling in **electives only**. Your core classes (English, Math, Science & Social Studies) have already been selected for you.
- If you are interested in taking any **Honors 8** core classes and are not currently in that honors course as a 7th grader, you will have to fill out a honors application and get teacher and parent signatures.
- Some elective classes also require an application to be filled out and turned in while others may require an audition.

Electives are either year-long (4 units) or semester-long (2 units) in length. Students typically take 2 class periods of electives (8 units) per school year. Registering in IC

- Remember, it is important to list your choices <u>in order</u> in Infinite Campus. You will want to click your 1st requested choice and then your 2nd choice, 3rd, and so on until it adds up to 8 requested units. Some electives are year-long (4 units) and others are semester-long (2 units) in length. Pay attention to this when making your choices.
- You will then prioritize your other 8 units as your alternates.
- Please note that when you print out the request summary the order is organized alphabetically. But as long as it is numbered in order of preference on your course selection form, we will try to honor your elective choices in order from 1-8. With your first few choices being requested.
- Remember, if you make a mistake or change your mind when choosing electives you can always delete it and rearrange your 16 unit preference list.

When do I register?


- Any time between Thursday, January 16th, 2025

- Sign up sooner rather than later in case you have questions or need more time.
- When the portal closes on Thursday January 23th, you will no longer be able to sign up for any elective classes and we will choose your electives for you (YIKES! You get what you get).




